

Our Mission Statement: In the spirit of Saint Francis, to know Jesus and make Him known.



Our lives are a series of building up and letting go.

The Gospel of John up to this Sunday's Gospel has Jesus saying often that his hour has not yet come. In today's passage with the arrival of the Greeks, who symbolize all the nations of the world seeking the one, true God, Jesus announces that his hour has come. It is time for him to "let go" and give his life so that all may have new life in and through him. And in this "hour" of laying down his life he honors his heavenly Father in an act of complete self-giving.

Jesus compares his suffering, death, and resurrection to a grain of wheat falling to the ground that fosters *new* growth and produces *abundant fruit*, all for the greater glory of God.

Paraphrasing Saint Iranaeus of Lyon, we hear that Jesus' sacrifice does not just yield ordinary fruit in abundance, but the food of everlasting life.

A cutting from the vine planted in the ground fructifies in its season. A corn of wheat falling into the earth decomposes, then rises with *manifold increase* by the Spirit of God, who contains all things. Then, through the wisdom of God, this wheat serves to feed and nourish all people, who have received the Word of God. The grain becomes the Eucharist, which is the body and blood of Christ; so, our bodies, being nourished by it, and deposited in the earth, and suffering decomposition there, shall rise at their appointed time, with our Lord, Jesus . . . the Word of God, who gives us a share in his resurrection *to the glory of God.*.."

By our letting go of empty pursuits that take up too much space in our hearts, we allow Jesus to fill us beyond our human capabilities. In this laying down of our lives with Jesus, we are promised that we will overflow with the "joy of our salvation" which we are called to share with others. This is why we let go and let God do the building.

Just as the nations of the world came to see Jesus based on his life of holiness, our lives, filled with the Holy Spirit, will attract others to Jesus for the glory of God the Father. In our letting go, we help build the Kingdom of Heaven on earth . . . transforming our world into a place of holy sacrifice, goodness, and love, that catches like wildfire.


