

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

This weekend we are entering into the Second Sunday of Easter. The first eight days of Easter is called the Octave of Easter and this Sunday completes the Easter Octave. Throughout all the fifty days of Easter Time, we rejoice as we reflect on what Christ has done for us, and as we extol the mystery of sharing in His life; as one of the Prefaces for Easter reminds us, "...by dying he has destroyed our death, and by rising, restored our life."

#### Alleluia!

Each year on the Second Sunday of Easter, we hear the story of the Doubting Thomas. It is a rough day for the Apostle. Not only does the poor fellow miss out on Jesus' first appearance to His Disciples, but he tells them that they must have dreamed it, and the only way he will believe Jesus has risen is to put his fingers into the wounds of Calvary. A week later, the Lord embarrasses him with just that invitation, "Trace My wounds" and he came to believe.

The story of Doubting Thomas is a great witness to us and for us. We couldn't be there in the upper room when the risen Christ appeared to the disciples. But someone much like us was. Thomas with all his questions and conditions and needs to touch found resurrection that he could hold onto. My Lord and My God. May fearless, joyous resurrection today be every bit as real and compelling for each of you. May we recognize the risen Christ in those around us and may they recognize the risen Christ in us by words and deeds.

St. John Paul II gave the additional title to the Second Sunday of Easter as "Divine Mercy Sunday." This title does not connote a new solemnity or feast, nor does it celebrate a new or separate mystery of redemption, but rather it leads us more deeply into the continuing celebration of God's mercy today and throughout all of Easter Season. At Saint Francis of Assisi Parish, we will be participating in special devotions to mark the day. Please plan on joining us at the Hour of Divine Mercy, 3:00pm on Sunday with the Exposition and Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, Confessions, chanting of the Divine Mercy Chaplet and we'll end with the Benediction at 4pm.




