

Communal anointings of the sick are celebrated. Individual anointings may be celebrated anytime by request.


HOSPITAL AND HOME VISITATION

Dear Parishioners,

The solar eclipse yesterday was short but it was one of those once-in-a-lifetime experiences for most of us. You may have realized that the Feast of the Annunciation was transferred to yesterday from March 25th due to the Holy Week. In art, the Blessed Virgin Mary is often betrayed as the moon and Jesus as the sun. As I reflected on what it was like to be in the "Path of Totality," I am moved to want my life to be in complete alignment with Jesus' will and Mary's "Yes" at the Annunciation. I hope and pray that each one of us is aligned here at Saint Francis of Assisi Parish where we can walk together fully united and always doing God's will together.



And the Gospel reading says: "Thus it is written that the Christ would suffer and rise from the dead on the third day and that repentance, for the forgiveness of sins, would be preached in his name...."

We are all liars in some way every day, professing our faith with our lips but not always in our behaviors. Our actions often say that we don't truly believe what we say about Christ's love. Our worries might be saying that we don't truly believe that God cares about each and every situation.

Our decisions say that we don't truly believe that Jesus knew what he was talking about when he commanded us to love our enemies and do good to those who hurt us. Our moral relativism says that we don't truly believe he was smarter than us when he gave us his commandments.

How loudly do your actions preach the truth about Jesus?

Many of us undervalue what Jesus has done for us, thinking that his death and resurrection is enough to get us into heaven; we neglect the need to humble ourselves under the reality of the need for daily redemption. God's not expecting perfection from us on this side of heaven's gate. What he does want, however, is our desire to become more and more like Christ every day. As long as we're continually examining our lives and educating ourselves about how we can improve, and following that up with doing what is necessary to produce changes, God is very pleased with us.

Questions for Personal Reflection:

What sinful tendencies still enslave you? What will you do this week to turn these over to Christ and his redemptive power?


