

# One Flock, One Shepherd

I have joked a few times over the past two years that when Bishop Frank sent me from Saint Luke in Westport to Saint Francis, that he sent me out to pasture. :) Of course I love the people of Saint Francis, our beautiful church, and the rural, pastoral setting. They are all conducive to welcoming and raising sheep... pasturing God's flock.

Are there any shepherds among us today? Maybe not in the strict sense of the term, but we are all called to shepherd someone in the faith at one time or another.



When asked what we do, we might say: I care for my children or my aging parent, I am a teacher, priest . . . I am a supervisor at my job, or I help organize food drives for Merton House or a scholarship fund to help educate our young adults. What is essential to all our individual vocations and spreading the Gospel, is that first: we must make a choice to make the effort; and second, the effort has to be rooted in love and compassion for it to bear fruit, such as Peter healing the cripple in Jesus' name.

Jesus says: "I have other sheep that are not a part of this fold. These also I must lead, and they will hear my voice, and there will be one flock, one shepherd." Jesus would like **us** to extend His healing and shepherding of souls to others, who might not be a part of our close circle of friends or acquaintances. This takes prayer and action, with, at times, prayer being the only action that we can take.

God gives us the grace to build and form new relationships, in person or through prayer, with those that may not be a part of our inner circles or yet a part of His flock. Imagine what it would be like if we each brought someone new to Mass each week. What if we extended consistent invitations to strangers, or someone who has been away from the faith, to one of the many social or spiritual events at Saint Francis? It takes some courage, a gift of the Holy Spirit, to invite others. It also takes time to get to know people on a deeper level by building rapport and trust by asking questions about their lives and listening with an open heart. You can see in peoples' eyes and demeanor some of what they are going through and pray: "Lord, what shall I say to this person right now?" The Holy Spirit will give us the right words to say.

Sometimes I think if I put half the effort into building new relationships based on the Gospel, that I put into my business, the church would be full each week, not out of obligation, but out of love. There would be 20 greeters before and after each Mass getting to know newcomers, all would sing as a prayer, kids would cry at the 9:30 am Mass and run down the aisles, those who are downcast would receive smiles, those who are confined to their homes would have visitors, and all would come to know the Lord.

Jesus says, "I am the Good Shepherd, and I know mine and mine know me, just as the Father knows me and I know the Father, and I will lay down my life for the sheep." When our lives are deeply rooted in Jesus, the Good Shepherd, those who hear our kind and gentle invitations will hear the voice of Jesus and follow. Saint Paul urges us on, "Behold, now is the acceptable time; behold, now is the day of salvation." To paraphrase Saint Augustine: Love and you will do it!


