

My Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Our Diocese will celebrate the annual **World Mission Appeal** the weekend of **October 19 – 20, 2024.** We will be invited again, with Catholics throughout the world, to recommit to our shared call to mission.

This World Mission Sunday, we echo Pope Francis' call to "Go and invite everyone to the banquet" (cf. Mt 22.9), we are reminded of our shared baptismal call to be missionary disciples. The collection taken up in our diocese offers us an exceptional opportunity to express our solidarity with the Church's missionary activities, support those who labor in the vineyard, especially in young Churches that need our prayerful and financial support.

Founded two hundred years ago by a French laywoman, Blessed Pauline Jaricot, The Pontifical Mission Societies supported the fledgling Church in the United States for the first decades of its life. We are now able to offer our support to our brothers and sisters in over 1,150 mission territories. It is a testament to the Church's universality and our collective responsibility to ensure that no diocese, large or small, wealthy or poor, is left behind in our mission activities.

Last year, The Pontifical Mission Societies provided grants to 38,000 seminarians, material support to 258,500 religious sisters caring for children and families and 844,000 catechists teaching the faith and helped sustain 8,700 homes for the elderly and orphaned children. The church in the United States contributed \$17.1 million towards these efforts which accounted for nearly 25% of the global giving.

Together let us pray for the success of the Church's mission and for the missionaries who serve with courage and love.




# Clothes, Shoes, Jackets ... infant to adult
