

Dear Friends in Christ,

We gather this weekend to celebrate the Feast of Corpus Christi, the Body and Blood of Christ. This solemnity reminds us of the greatest gift that Christ gave to us, His very life, His own body and blood. This is a gift given freely to each of us to enable us to grow in our faith and have the strength to embrace and live the teachings of the Gospel. When we reflect on the sacrifices that Christ underwent for us, His suffering and death, we remember that it was His death that gave us life. That life is renewed every time we receive the Holy Eucharist.

The sadness of these times is how many Catholics no longer receive this greatest of all gifts. Let us receive Eucharist more earnestly and reverently. Let us partake of this life-giving gift with a newness of heart. Jesus tells us unless we eat of His body and drink of His blood, we have no life in us. Let us find our way back to that life and encourage others to do the same!
