*Students can wear a Valentine's Day theme shirt or dress in Valentine's Day colors of red, pink, or purple

*Students will not need to bring a snack or their water bottle that day – yummy Valentine's Day snacks and treats will be provided for my students

***Students will be making their Valentine's Day bags in class as part of an art lesson** (therefore, you don't need to make one at home to send in)

*Students may bring in Valentine Day cards to share with their friends- I will be sending home a list of the students' names to help you and your child address their cards

*Your child may also bring in a treat bag to share with their classmates if they would like

***All cards/treat bags must to sent in the morning of our party with the student**

*Please either keep your child's cards separate from their treat bags or attach their Valentine's Day cards to the outside of their treat bags – this will help in the distribution of the items to their classmates (all items will be passed out before the start of our celebration)
