



THE ROSARY



Our Most Powerful Weapon



Many of you have probably never thought of the Rosary as a weapon, but that is exactly what it is. Many of the great saints of the Church have spoken about the Rosary as an exceptionally powerful weapon against the forces of evil and sin in our own lives and in the world. For example, St. Josemaria Escriva said, "The holy Rosary is a powerful weapon. Use it with confidence and you'll be amazed at the results." Pope Pius XI also spoke of the Rosary's power saying, "The Rosary is a powerful weapon to put the demons to flight and to keep oneself from sin. If you desire peace in your hearts, in your homes, and in your country, assemble each evening to recite the Rosary. Let not even one day pass without saying it, no matter how burdened you may be with many cares and labors."

One of the most famous examples of this is the victory of the Holy League against the Ottoman Empire at the Battle of Lepanto on October 7, 1571. The Holy League was outnumbered so Pope Pius V asked all the faithful to pray the Rosary for their victory. During the battle, the wind shifted leading to the dramatic victory of the Holy League over the Ottoman Empire stopping their expansion into Europe. After the battle, it was the Rosary and Our Lady that was given credit for the victory and Pope Pius established the feast of Our Lady of Victory known today as the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary. In more recent times, Jesus would again show us the power of the Rosary. In 2014 the radical Islamic group Boko Haram was terrorizing Nigeria through the kidnapping of girls and murder. One day Bishop Oliver Dashe Doeme of Maiduguri, Nigeria was praying his rosary. Jesus appeared to him holding a sword in his hands. Jesus extended the sword to the bishop. When the bishop took the sword it was miraculously transformed into a Rosary. Bishop Doeme said, "I didn't need a prophet to give me an explanation. It was clear that with the rosary we would be able to expel Boko Haram." He began a rosary crusade in his diocese and between October 2016 and May 2017 dozens of kidnapped girls were released by Boko Haram. On July 3, 2017 hundreds of members of Boko Haram surrendered their weapons and turned themselves in to the Nigerian authorities. Indeed, we can see that the rosary is truly a weapon against



evil.


