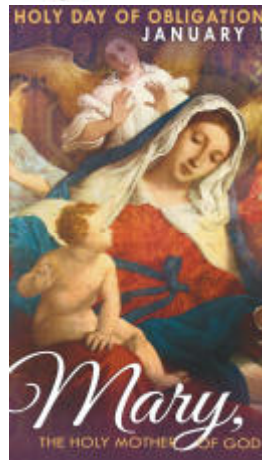

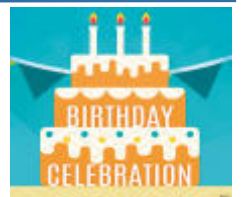
Why do Catholics honor Mary as Mother of God?
