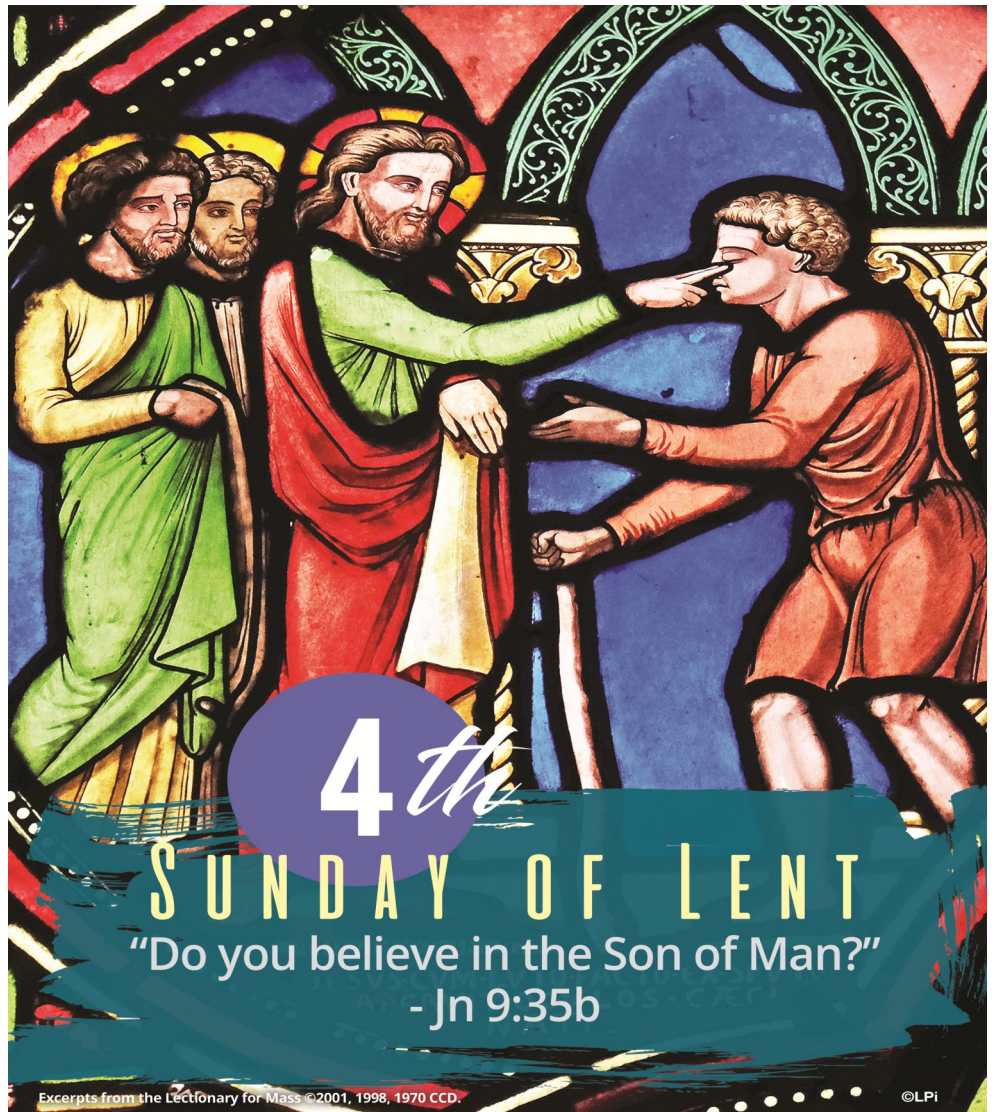

Talking about discipleship and truly being a disciple are two very different things. It is easier to know what we should do than to carry out. Many saints from our tradition have had much to say about this struggle to do what they know they must do, and not do that which they know they shouldn't. It is part of being human.

Without God, we have no chance to overcome this predicament. Without God, our actions can ring hollow, or often we are too immobilized to act at all. Without God, we suffer with blindness to the truth of what is important and eternal.

The story in John 9 of Jesus healing the blind man is about more than a physical healing and just one man. It is about how each of us can find healing of our blindness by turning to Jesus Christ. Are you someone that has been saying, "I don't understand all this talk of discipleship and stewardship; what's the big deal?" We all have a blindness that needs to be healed, and the body of Christ needs you so that God's presence in our world can be seen in a more profound manner. The reality is that God heals the blindness of those who seek him so that, in turn, they may be vehicles by which others may see as well.

This Lent, you are invited to bring your blindness to Jesus. All the written reflections in the world will not give you new eyes. Those eyes can only be found in Jesus.

FROM OUR PASTOR

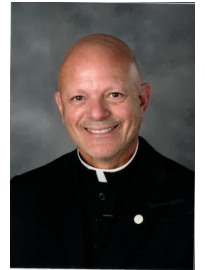


My dear parishioners,

We continue our Lenten journey with the readings for this Sunday reminding us that God sees in a different way than we see, and that He is always interested in restoring our sight so that we can see like He sees. The passage of the man born blind is another passage that helps us to reflect on the importance of conversion. The key to this passage is that the man born blind goes through an incredible transition from “the man called Jesus,” to “a prophet,” to “I believe.” As we get closer and closer to Holy Week, let us ask the Lord to help us to see the importance of our own conversion. That conversion is a constant call for all of us, that we take time every year during Lent to make a personal inventory as to how well we are following the teachings of Jesus.

For adults: What do you understand for conversion in your life? It should not be a vague idea. It should be very clear and practical as to what in your life needs to change to live according to what God wants.

For parents with children: Talk to your children about why do you believe in God, and if you have a conversion experience in your life, make sure they know about it.

WHY DO SOME CONVERSIONS HAPPEN DURING LENT?

Every year it happens. Someone who ignored God for years suddenly feels restless. Someone who mocked the Church starts asking questions. Someone who hasn't confessed in decades walks into a confessional during Lent... and comes out different. Why Lent? It's not accidental.

LENT CREATES SPACE FOR GOD

Lent strips things away. Less food. Less noise. Less distraction. When the body is quieted, the soul becomes audible. Fasting weakens the ego. Prayer sharpens awareness. Silence exposes hunger. And sometimes, for the first time, a person realizes: "I am not okay." That realization is the beginning of conversion.

THE CROSS BECOMES IMPOSSIBLE TO IGNORE

During Lent, the Church fixes her gaze on one thing: The Cross. The suffering of Jesus Christ is proclaimed more intensely. His Passion is read. His wounds are contemplated. And something about the Cross disarms pride. You can argue philosophy. You can debate doctrine. But it's harder to stand before a crucified Savior and remain indifferent. The Cross confronts. The Cross exposes. The Cross invites.

GRACE IS NOT SEASONAL, BUT HEARTS ARE

God is always offering grace. But humans respond differently in different seasons. Lent carries a collective atmosphere of repentance. More confessions. More preaching on sin and mercy. More reflection on mortality.



Even culturally, there is an awareness: "This is a serious time." And grace often rides on seriousness.

THE CHURCH EXPECTS IT

That's why many conversions culminate at the Easter Vigil. After weeks of purification, after scrutiny, after instruction, people are baptized, confirmed, and received into the Church. Because Lent is designed as a journey from death to life. From ashes to resurrection.

HERE IS THE DEEPER TRUTH

Conversion happens when illusion collapses. Lent accelerates that collapse. When comfort decreases, when conscience speaks louder, when Christ crucified stands at the center, hearts soften. Not because Lent is magical. But because it is honest. And honesty is where grace enters. If someone feels drawn back to God during Lent, it is not coincidence. It is mercy knocking louder than usual. And the wisest thing a person can do...is open the door.

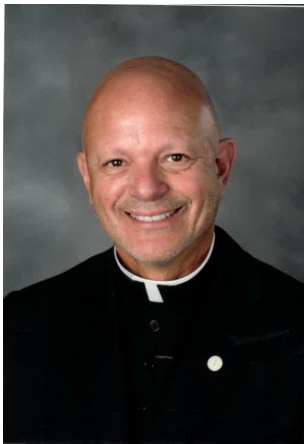
Mis queridos feligreses,

La clave para este evangelio tan lindo es que este hombre que nació ciego pasa por un proceso increíble de conversión. El experimenta una transición en cuanto a cómo veía a Jesús de ser simplemente “un hombre llamado Jesús,” a “un profeta,” a “Sí, creo.” Al acercarnos cada vez más a la Semana Mayor, la Semana Santa, pidámosle al Señor que nos ayude a ver la importancia de nuestra conversión. 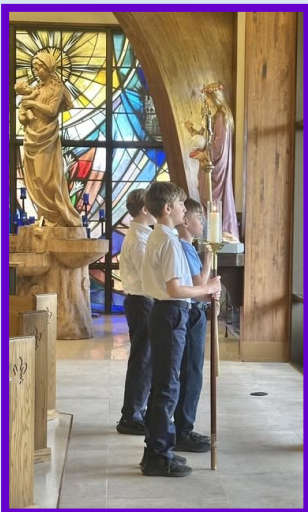

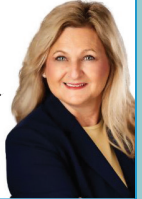

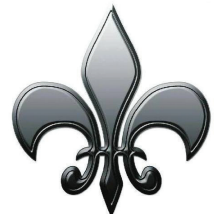
