Pastor's Letter for the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time— Year A—January 21-22

***Land of Zebulun and land of Naphtali,
the way to the sea, beyond the Jordan,
Galilee of the Gentiles,
the people who sit in darkness have seen a great light,
on those dwelling in a land overshadowed by death
light has arisen.***

In the prophecy of Isaiah, it is predicted that the land of Galilee to the north, along the sea, once dominated by Gentiles, conquered by the Assyrians long ago, would see a great light. That prophecy is fulfilled when Jesus walks along that same seaward road, and calls his first four apostles from among the many fishermen working along the shore.

The two sets of brothers, Simon (Peter) and Andrew, and James and John, would become the first four men to help Jesus in his great mission of bringing about the Kingdom of God on earth. Their immediate response to Jesus' invitation would take them far beyond their comfortable lives in Galilee.

Three of the four would be martyred, James was the first apostle to die, by the sword, as recorded in the Acts of the Apostles, Peter and Andrew were both crucified, and John was imprisoned on the island of Patmos.

But their lives, though turned upside down, became lives full of adventure and passion, lives transformed by Jesus and his message. Should ours be any different? When the Lord calls us, let us drop what we were doing and go, and our lives will never be the same again!

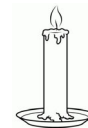

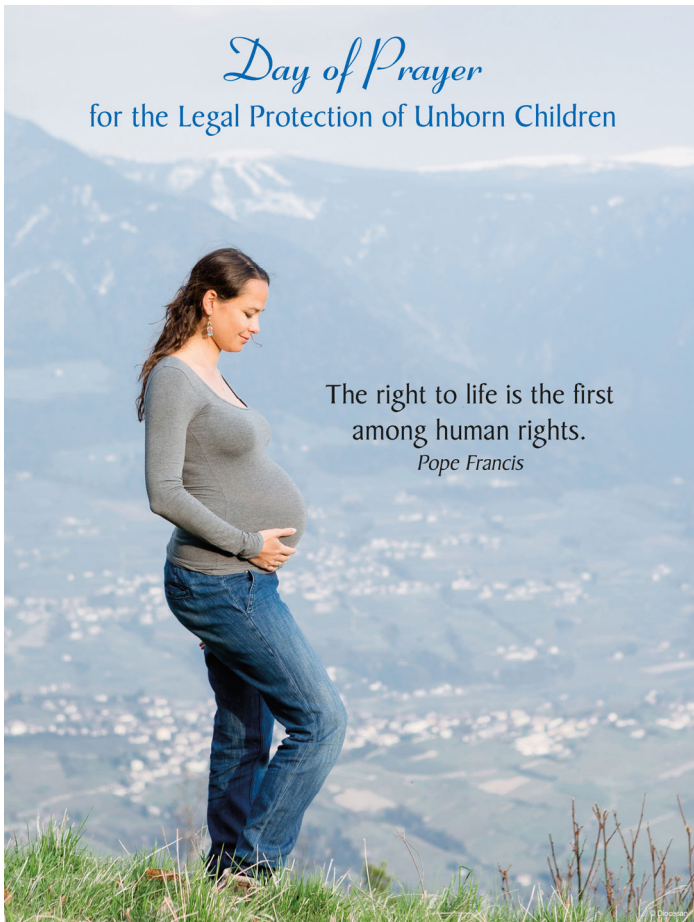

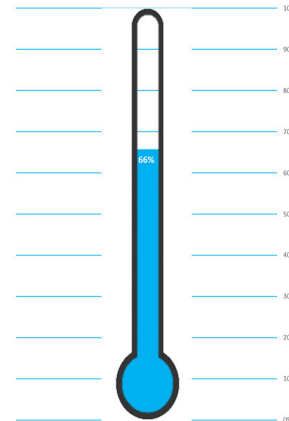
