2017-2018 Pep Squad Guidelines

- 1. Membership is open to girls in grades Kindergarten -3^{rd} .
- 2. Members must be familiar with and follow the guidelines stated. A member who must be continually reminded of these guidelines may be dismissed from the squad.
- 3. In order to maintain membership, ALL squad members must meet academic requirements for eligibility of no less than a "C" average in all subjects and no less than a "B" in conduct. Any member who does not meet the requirements will have a grace period (until progress reports) to bring the grade up. If grades do not meet the requirements after the grace period, the member will be dismissed from the squad.
- 4. Any squad member receiving a school suspension will be dismissed from the squad.
- 5. SEAS Pep Squad represents the school. Members are expected to avoid activities and situations that could be detrimental to the reputation of the squad or school.
- 6. Any member who is removed from the squad will not be allowed to join the following year.
- 7. Attendance is expected at all squad activities. If a member cannot attend an activity, the moderators must be notified.
- 8. Practice will be on Tuesdays from 3:30-4:30 outside of the Early Childhood Center. On rainy days, we will hold practice in the PE room. Games may be any day of the week. We will try to only have a pep squad activity once a week whenever possible. A monthly calendar will be sent with all activities listed.
- 9. During practices and games, members are expected to cooperate with the moderators and coaches. Failure to do so may result in dismissal.
- 10. No friends are allowed at practices unless given permission by the moderators.
- **11.** Members must be picked up promptly from all activities.

Practice and games at SEAS – If member isn't picked up within 10 minutes of scheduled end time, she will be brought to extended care.

Games away from SEAS – If member isn't picked up within 10 minutes of scheduled end time, a childcare fee of \$1 per minute will be charged for each minute past the end time.

- 12. Please send a note if your child needs to go to extended care after practice or games at SEAS.
- 13. Please send a snack and water for your child on practice days.
- **14.** Practice shirts must be worn at every practice.

DUES

We will collect \$40 in dues from each squad member. This will go towards squad parties, snacks at games at SEAS, and all expenses for our end of year banquet. We can only accept a check made out to SEAS.

Money will not be refunded to members who leave or are dismissed from the squad.

Uniform Information

All members must have the following uniform pieces. If you already have these items, it is not necessary to order new ones.

- Green pep squad t-shirt (to be worn at each practice)
- Pep Squad cheerleader uniform (top and skirt)
- Cheer briefs (bloomers)
- Pom-poms
- Cheer bow (we will use the one from last year)

The following are required and may be purchased at the store of your choice.

- White turtleneck (order from us or purchase on your own)
- Nude tights
- White tennis shoes (no color on them please)
- Solid white socks

The following are optional items that may be ordered.
