I invite you to consider enrolling your child in the school band. Students in grades 4-7 may participate, and band classes will meet on Mondays during the school day. SEAS band students will perform Christmas and Spring Concerts, and the Advanced Band members will have the opportunity to perform at the Archdiocesan Band Festival later in the school year.

I am excited to offer band classes again this year. I previously taught band at St. Elizabeth during 2000-2007, and I returned to SEAS last year. Professionally I have over 30 years of teaching experience. I taught clarinet and saxophone at Tulane University from 1983-2005, and I have worked with the Arch Band Program since 1998. I perform regularly on the saxophone and clarinet, and presently I perform most often with *The Wiseguys*, a local band.

## Renting or purchasing your band instrument

Students must provide their instrument in band class. Some parents choose to start with a rental plan. Beginner band members are not required to have their instruments by the first day of band. # Selecting your instrument-"Instrument Trials" for beginning band members

I recommend that beginning band members explore and play some of the band instruments before selecting one. Beginner band instruments include the flute, clarinet, alto saxophone, trumpet, trombone, baritone, snare drum, & bells (xylophone). During an "instrument trial" students and parents may explore the instruments together, and I will offer my recommendations. I will offer "instrument trials" at Michon Music on <u>August 29</u>, and other dates can be arranged if needed. Trials will be offered in order of arrival on Saturday.

<u>Saturday, August 29-1:30-4:00pm</u> at Michon Music, 3200 Severn Ave, Metairie (across from Lakeside) <u>Other "instrument trial" dates</u> will be available if needed, possibly even during the school day. You may contact me with your requests.

The registration cost includes a non-refundable \$50 fee. There is a \$50 fee for each NSF check. Your payment directly determines the monthly salary of the music teacher as well as the administrative and operational cost of running the program. The band program is not subsidized by any outside entity. Once your registration and payment is received and processed, a band method book will be issued to your child. THIRD CHILD IS FREE!! There is a \$15 late fee if the balance is not paid on time and \$5 for additional months. Please notify THIS OFFICE if your child needs to withdraw. If appropriate, \$25 per month is refundable should lessons be discontinued. The request for a refund must be done in writing with a stamped, self-addressed envelope to the band office by the 1<sup>st</sup> of the month. There are no refunds after April 1, 2016. Your child's band instructor should also be notified in writing.

Our program is offered where the school cannot budget for a music teacher. If you were to get private or semi-private lessons, the cost PER LESSON would be \$20 - \$30.
