Listen To Jesus And The Prophets

Prophets have always had a tough row to hoe. Their words, often unwelcome, are used against them to persecute and even kill them. Such was the fate of the Old Testament prophets, and Jeremiah is a great example of this. Jesus endured opposition from sinners, and did not turn back from a shameful death in order to rise to a glorious new life. The ultimate prophet, Jesus sought to warn the people of his time and ours of the divisions that his words would cause, showing himself to be the prophet of all time. We all need to look at our divisions and dilemmas in light of Jesus' teachings and warnings, and seek to understand all that he has proclaimed and taught about what will happen if we fail to listen.

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Treasures From Our Tradition

In recent weeks, we have reviewed how the Churches of East and West have enriched one another, and this past Thursday's solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary was born in the Eastern Church. It is a gift from the ancient Church of Jerusalem, a commemoration of the death of Mary, and a feast charged with a deep sense of the Resurrection. Mary, the first disciple, is the first to share fully in Christ's victory over death. In the tradition of the East, August 15th is the "Dormition of the Theotokos," or the "Falling Asleep of the God-bearer." There is no shadow of death or gloom in the theology, since this is seen as a transformation of Mary's life into a heavenly and immortal existence. There is a sense in the tradition that she who made earth heavenly and exalted the human race by her faithfulness is glorified today.

A persistent legend among Orthodox Christians tells how all the disciples, except Thomas, who was preaching in India, were present at Mary's death and burial, and sat by the tomb for three days. On the third day, Thomas saw Mary's body rising to heaven. She greeted him as "my friend," and he was escorted by angels to proclaim her assumption to the others, who then realized her tomb was empty. Thus Thomas, the one who expressed doubt at the resurrection of Christ, received a gift from Mary: the chance to proclaim resurrection faith to the disciples.

On Fire

Jesus' intentions to "set the earth on fire" and to cause division were disturbing to his listeners, and may be disturbing to us, too. In the Old Testament, fire was seen as the means of God's purification and judgment, truly a gift to the people. The fire destroys our illusions about ourselves and our behaviors. It burns away obstacles to a loving relationship with God. God's fire melts any institutions, beliefs, or practices that enable evil and injustice.

Jesus came to expose evil and thereby force decisions about God's true nature and purposes. Divisions emerged because of the diverse choices people made. Does Jesus represent some demonic power, or the true God? Do we fight to preserve current attitudes and behaviors, or do we enter the path offered by Jesus? In evoking fire, Jesus is certainly not suggesting violence or disrespect toward others. Jesus lights a fire, and then in his death, bears its results. It is a fire of sacrificial love, melting cold hearts and bringing light to a darkened world.

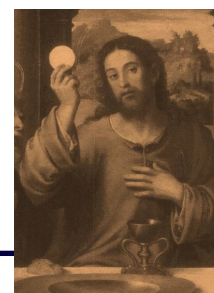

Lord, Teach Me To Pray



"LORD, TEACH ME TO PRAY"

This fall at OUR LADY OF THE LAKE PARISH

"Lord, Teach Me To Pray" (LTMTPray) is a three-part prayer series, rooted in Ignatian spirituality and designed to help women learn how to pray. The three parts are taken in succession. Each part is a prerequisite for the next part. Our Lady of the Lake will be offering both Part 1 and Part 2 this fall.

Part 1, Praying Christian Virtues (12 weeks), introduces Ignatian prayer and spirituality in the way that St. Ignatius himself introduced people; i.e., by structuring their initial prayer experience around the Christian Virtues. Part 1 is conducted in a small group experience. Each group will meet for two hours once a week for prayer, faith sharing and introduction to the methods of Ignatian prayer. Everyone will receive Scriptures on the virtues to use daily at home for 15 minutes of private prayer. **The Part 1 series starts Thursday, September 5th at 6pm please email Allison McInnis at gmmcinnis@att.net to enroll.**

Part 2, My 19th Annotation (30 weeks), consists of the entirety of the well-known "Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius". The title of this part of the series refers to the 19th note that St. Ignatius wrote in his notebook. In this note he wrote that a person taken up with "public affairs or suitable business" and unable to withdraw from the world for prayer may experience the prayer of the Spiritual Exercises in his daily life. Pt. 2 is conducted in a small group experience with two trained facilitators. You must have completed Part 1 to take Part 2. Each group will meet for two hours once a week for prayer, faith sharing and will receive material on the Spiritual Exercises and Scriptures to use for their private prayer of 30-45 minutes daily. Pt. 2 is 27 weeks which is divided into two semesters with a month break in the middle. **There will be nighttime series starting August 21st at 6:00 pm please contact Angie Kangas at Angiek@drumbo.com. The daytime series will start Sept 5 at 9:30 am in Fellowship 1 please call Claire Fariss at 504-232-7444**

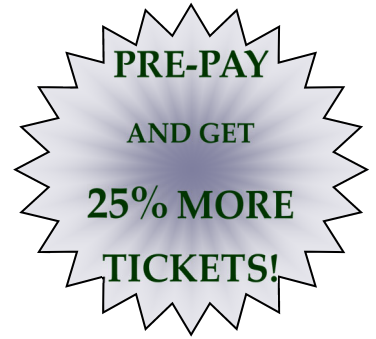

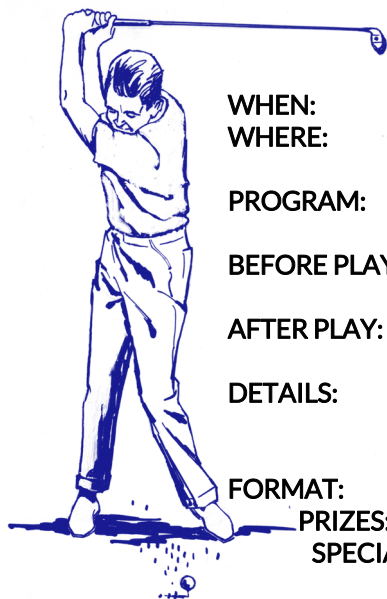

Safe Environment Training

All those who serve in ministry with children are required to complete Safe Environment Training. **OLL will have initial Safe Environment training on August 21st at 7:15 PM in the Chotin Center**, and St. John of the Cross in Lacombe will have it on August 22nd at 6 PM.

Renewal for Safe Environment Training for Adult Learners only is now being offered online. This training works on computers, tablets and smartphones. This is not for your initial training with the Archdiocese...only for renewals. Training expires every three years. If you are due for renewal, follow these steps:

1. Go to <https://safeandsacred-nola.org>
2. Click the "Create new account" button to register
3. Complete ALL information on the registration page
4. Click "Create my new account" to complete your registration
5. Click "Continue" to confirm your account and enter the training site.
6. Complete the training. You are done with training when you see your certificate on the screen.

Financial Stewardship and RAS Status

Why should I give to the Church?

Only with the sacrificial offering of all our members, can we ensure that Our Lady of the Lake remains a vibrant, active faith community. Make contributions weekly, monthly or one time prior to the end of 2019 to total \$450. When giving cash, please use envelopes with donor identification for proper accounting. Contributions can be made online by credit card or direct debit through Online Giving. Go to our website at www.ollparish.info and click on the link. Set up the account and make a "Weekly Offering". Once you choose this option, you can further decide to make your payment monthly, weekly or one time. Be aware that credit transactions take 2-3 days to process.

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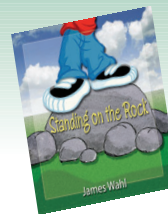
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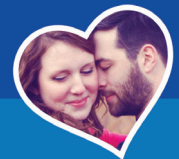

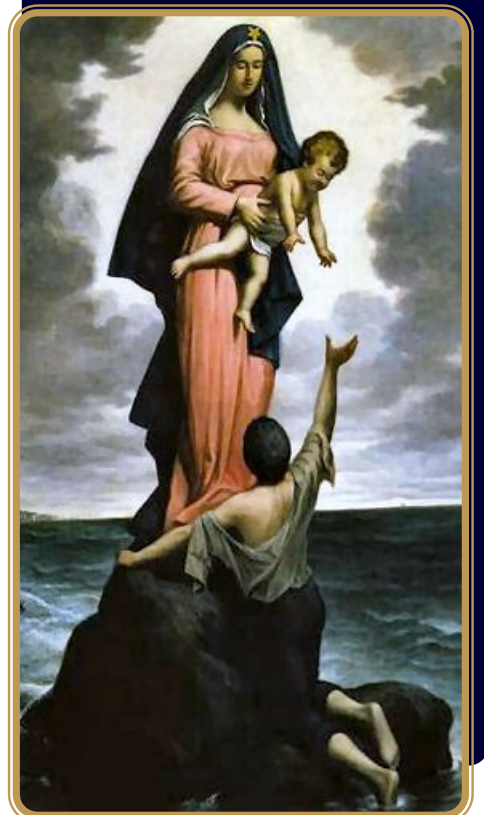
