### A Message of Love

In the final verses of today's Gospel reading Jesus says that when two or three are gathered in his name, "there am I in the midst of them" (Matthew 18:20). So we understand that fraternal correction is always undertaken with Jesus present to us.

Likewise, encouraging the good in others is not only the right thing for us to do, it is a necessity. The Lord tells the prophet Ezekiel that if he "does not speak out" to dissuade a person from evil, then he too will be held responsible.

We live in a "do your own thing" age when moral objectivity is often ignored. Clearly when the message we share with others is one of love, our motives cannot ever be misinterpreted. As St. Paul writes, "Love does no evil to the neighbor; hence, love is the fulfillment of the law" (Romans 13:10). *Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co.*

### September 9: St. Peter Claver (1581-1654)

Nearly two hundred years before the Declaration of Independence proclaimed "that all men are created equal," two hundred fifty years before the Emancipation Proclamation mandated an end to slavery, three hundred fifty years before Martin Luther King's "I Have a Dream," and four hundred years before the election of an American president boasting African heritage, Peter Claver left his native Spain behind to volunteer for the Jesuit missions in Colombia. There, he was horrified both by slavery as an institution and by the inhuman brutality inflicted upon the slaves. He solemnly vowed to become "the slave of the slaves," and lived that vow heroically for close to forty years. Not knowing their language, Peter began his ministry among the slaves by using the universal language of practical charity, providing medical care and a tangible though wordless assertion of their human dignity: "We spoke to them not with words but with our hands, kneeling beside them, bathing their faces and bodies, encouraging them with friendly gestures" (see *Liturgy of the Hours, Volume 4*, p. 2018). Then came evangelization and baptism. Holiness as human wholeness: Peter Claver's enduring witness.

## Not My Problem

Ever notice how people today like to ignore the evil in the world? People will witness a mugging and not bother to call the police. We see television stories of children starving in poor countries and say, "Not my problem." The readings for this Sunday challenge this attitude.

In the Gospel, Jesus' words teach us something about our duty to the sinner. First, he tells us that sin is our problem, and when we see it we need to take the initiative to stop it. Second, he tells us we need not feel alone in this duty. When the sinner refuses to listen, we bring in help. In fact, this command is meant for the whole church. Third, he tells us to be persistent; don't give up on someone too easily.

So what about that line about treating the sinner who refuses to listen as a Gentile or tax collector? On the one hand, the sinner would be excluded from the church, excommunicated, if he doesn't repent. On the other hand, Jesus never rejected tax collectors (like Matthew himself, who wrote this Gospel) or Gentiles. He said he came to call sinners, to save them. He loves sinners. And that is the reason we are to confront them—not to punish them, but to love them. For God never forces a person to repent. God invites with love, especially the love Jesus showed by dying on the cross. May we all learn to fight evil with love!

### Vocation Spotlight: Seminarian Kevin Seay

There were a few different times in college when the thought of becoming a priest was at the forefront of my mind. That desire to become a priest, although strong, never remained for very long. Something else always caught my attention, whether it was a girl or wanting to enjoy college without worrying about discernment. Even as college ended, I didn't give much consideration to entering seminary. I had put those thoughts and desires on the back burner for most of my senior year.

I did love studying theology though. I majored in economics but added theology as a second major towards the end of college and eventually looked for a place to study theology at the graduate level. Grad school at Saint Louis University was much different from college. I had to spend much more time reading and writing and no longer lived with my best friends. That left me with a lot more time in quiet and by myself. I didn't like this sudden change, especially in the beginning, but I came to experience how being alone, if done right, can turn into being alone with God. That was a bit of a game-changer for me. It helped my prayer, and it also allowed me to see that I could be fulfilled by God, even if I was not dating or surrounded by my best friends. God alone is enough! In these times of silence, I ended up working through questions that I pushed aside in college. I thought about what I wanted out of life. I brought into prayer questions like what in life is truly most important and most valuable. While working through these questions, the desire to enter seminary grew louder and louder.

I entered seminary in the Fall of 2018. Although I entered seminary without a clear sense that I was being called, I was put at ease by what the head of the seminary said in our first meeting. Father Wehner said, "your real discernment begins here. Everything before seminary can be considered 'pre-discernment.' It's here that you, with the Church, will discern whether or not you're being called to the priesthood." With these words, I realized that I was exactly where I needed to be. I didn't need to figure out my vocation on my own before entering seminary. I simply had to pour myself into formation and try to be moldable clay before Christ and his Body.

I guess it shouldn't have come as a surprise, but in seminary you're able to give so much attention to personal growth, fellowship, and your relationship with Jesus. Seminary has been a lot of work and trying at times but, nevertheless, great and transformative. Now that I have been in formation for two years, there has been greater clarity in my discernment. God seems to be confirming my desire for the priesthood and is leading me along that path. God willing, I will be ordained a priest in 2023.

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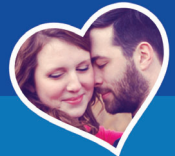


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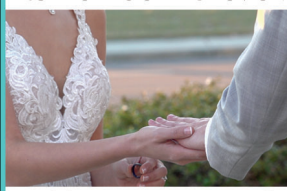
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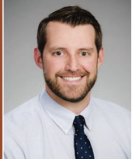


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## Administration and Operations

### Financial Stewardship and RAS Status

**Why should I give to the Church?** Only with the sacrificial offering of all our members, can we ensure that Our Lady of the Lake remains a vibrant, active faith community. With your offering you can ensure that we are able to meet our financial obligations to maintain our ministries, programs and facilities, pay a just wage to our parish staff, support the needs of the larger Church and assist our brothers and sisters in need.

**What is RAS?** RAS stands for Registered, Active and Supporting of the parish. When registering for the school or for PSR classes, each family is asked to be a Registered, Active and Supporting member of the parish. Our Lady of the Lake has set a minimum financial amount of \$450 per family, per calendar year to be considered an RAS member. Those who do not meet these requirements are asked to pay an additional fee.

**How can I fulfill my RAS minimum amount for 2020?** Make contributions weekly, monthly or one time prior to the end of 2020 to total \$450. When giving cash, please use envelopes with donor identification for proper accounting. Contributions can be made online by credit card or direct debit through Online Giving. Go to our website at [www.ollparish.info](http://www.ollparish.info) and click on the link. Set up the account and make a "Weekly Offering". Once you choose this option, you can further decide to make your payment monthly, weekly or one time. Be aware that credit transactions take 2-3 days to process.

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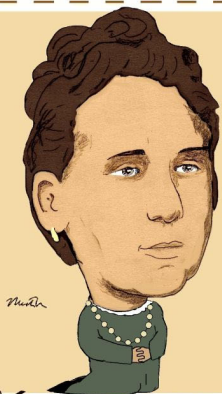
