

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

It was in the seminary that I first learned about the "O" Antiphons as Christmas was approaching. What are they?

According to the United States Congress of Catholic Bishops, the Roman Church has been singing the "O" Antiphons since at least the eighth century. They are the antiphons that accompany the Magnificat canticle of Evening Prayer from December 17-23. They use ancient biblical imagery drawn from the messianic hopes of the Old Testament to proclaim the coming Christ as the fulfillment not only of Old Testament hopes, but present ones as well. Their repeated use of the imperative "Come!" embodies the longing of all for the Divine Messiah. Maybe the best definition comes from Cardinal Newman. He wrote, "Antiphons are not, strictly speaking, Prayers, but sentences applied to the particular purpose of meditation, thanksgiving & ..." An antiphon is a verse that gives emphasis to what follows, such as a prayer, psalm, Scripture or canticle. Here they are:

#### December 17

O Wisdom of our God Most High, guiding creation with power and love: come to teach us the path of knowledge!

#### December 18

O Leader of the House of Israel, giver of the Law to Moses on Sinai: come to rescue us with your mighty power!

#### December 19

O Root of Jesse's stem, sign of God's love for all his people: come to save us without delay!

#### December 20

O Key of David, opening the gates of God's eternal Kingdom: come and free the prisoners of darkness!

#### December 21

O Radiant Dawn, splendor of eternal light, sun of justice: come and shine on those who dwell in darkness and in the shadow of death.

#### December 22

O King of all nations and keystone of the Church: come and save man, whom you formed from the dust!

#### December 23


O Emmanuel, our King and Giver of Law: come to save us, Lord our God!
