FATHER PAUL'S POST

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

Jesus says to Peter today, "You are thinking not as God does, but as human beings do." In some ways, that sounds unfair. How are we expected to think like God thinks?



It's a good question! Maybe, if we tried really hard, do you think we could? We only have what our human body has given us. We can't help but think like human beings do because that is what we are! Yet, there is something that helps us to think not like human beings, but like God thinks! That is called faith!

It's faith that helps us to overcome obstacles from our human weakness. Jesus is the master teacher! When we can surrender to ourselves and listen and learn from Him, we can start to see things and know things that God sees and knows. That's true even if we are unable to grasp it all at once!
