

## FATHER PAUL'S POST

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

In today's aospel parable from Mark, we hear the phrase "The Word" used. In our culture, it is the written words that have significant value (as in a legal document). The spoken word



doesn't have much power. In more ancient cultures, the spoken word is more valued! In the Bible, when a person speaks (as in a prophet), that persons' word can create the future, either in blessing or in curse.

This may be a good lesson for us this week as we celebrate Father's Day! It's a good week to thank fathers, grandfathers, stepfathers, foster-fathers, godfathers in our lives. If we can, they should hear it from our voice. If we are unable to do that, it's good to lift them in prayer.

This week we also celebrate as a country our newest holiday, Juneteenth. The National Museum of African American History and Culture writes that it was on "June 19, 1865, when some 2,000 Union troops arrived in Galveston Bay, Texas. The army announced that the more than 250,000 enslaved black people in the state, were free by executive decree. This day came to be known as Juneteenth by the newly freed people in Texas."

It's good for us to remember this history, as this news was spoken to the people in Texas 159 years ago. Knowing our history can help us shape the future for more blessings and help heal the curses of the past.
