

## A POST FROM FR. PAUL



Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

One point in the gospel this week relates to judging others. Some have a responsibility to judge the behavior of others: parents, teachers, doctors, safety personnel, etc. We judge the people we vote into office to govern. We judge people whose behavior affects us in a negative way (like someone driving the wrong way on a one way street).

We do make judgements. However, people don't need our anger. They need our prayers. It can be easy at times to get a bit carried away in our judgment of others. We may pick up stones to throw at them. These may not be physical stones. They could be verbal stones: destructive and negative words that tear down. Sometimes those destructive words can be called gossip.

It's good for us to remember Jesus' words: "Let him who is without sin be the first one to cast a stone at her." We do have a responsibility to live as Christ taught us. Remember, when we get down on ourselves over our weakness, we need to remember the Lord is always kind and merciful to those who turn to him for forgiveness! Have a blessed week!

A rich Lenten reflection, this prayer can help open our hearts to the persistent sin of racism and the call to help overcome it.




