

I am one of many parishioners and priests who was delighted to hear the news that Pope Francis recently named our good friend, Father Richard Reidy, a Chaplain to His Holiness with the title of 'Reverend Monsignor.' He certainly deserves this honor and title. He has served as Vicar General of the Diocese for more than ten years now and his responsibilities take him into the life of virtually every parish. He also has oversight for many diocesan committees. During these years he has had to administrate numerous parishes in the absence of a pastor. And this is to say nothing of the great contribution he has made at Christ the King these past ten years as he celebrates Mass each day and so generously preaches at Masses too numerous to mention. He is ever so prayerful and a true servant of all and has a heart of gold.

I have had the good fortune of living with Monsignor Reidy twice. When I was Chancellor of the Diocese, and he was the Rector of St. Paul's Cathedral I lived with him from 2004 to 2008 (when he was sent on for canon law studies). When he assumed much of what I was doing in 2013 he came to live here. That has been a special joy for me!

We look forward to the day when there will be a diocesan celebration when Bishop McManus will formally install him (but the honor and title took effect immediately this past September 28).

The 12th Annual Novena to St. Joseph Continues Tomorrow ~ October 9

Please join us for the Novena to St. Joseph tomorrow evening. The Novena will be celebrated for nine consecutive Mondays from 7:15 pm to 8:00 pm. We pray for the sick, pray for improvements in palliative care, and pray to oppose all attempts to end human life unnaturally as in the case of physician assisted suicide. Rev. John J. Gavin, S.J., Associate Professor of Religious Studies at the College of the Holy Cross, will be our homilist.

The schedule of remaining homilists is: Oct. 16, Rev. Robert A. Grattaroti; Oct. 23, Rev. Richard W. Polek; Oct. 30, Rev. Enoch Kyeremateng; and Nov. 6, Rev. Msgr. Thomas J. Sullivan. We hope that you will participate in this important annual event as the pressure increases on the state legislature to make physician assisted suicide the law in Massachusetts.
