

There are many adults and youths who are not baptized, confirmed and/or have never received Holy Communion. We'd love you to become full and active members of the Catholic Church. Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults - For non-baptized adults; for baptized Christians who wish to become Catholic; for baptized Catholic adults (without First Communion or Confirmation) and with little or no religious formation. Adult Confirmation Prep - For baptized and practicing Catholics who have received First Communion but were never confirmed.

The Sacrament of 'The Anointing of the Sick' At All Masses Next Weekend

At all our Masses next weekend, May 25-26, we will offer the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick to any person who wishes to receive it. You will remember that it has been our custom to offer the sacrament in this manner twice a year. We hope that anyone afflicted by a serious physical or emotional illness, those recovering from or preparing for surgery, or those who experience age-related limitations will receive the sacrament. In the sacrament we always receive the grace of God's healing. The two essential parts of the sacrament are the 'laying on' of hands and the anointing with the *Oil of the Sick*. The celebration of this Sacrament, with the whole community present and praying for one another, is always a powerful and beautiful experience. Please consider in advance if you would like to receive this Sacrament of Healing.

'HOPE FOR HOUSING' CARDS

Here's how they work: You purchase food or gift cards in various amounts of \$10 to \$100; You use the food cards for your shopping; You receive the full-face value of the card you purchase; What you don't spend remains on your card for later use; The supermarket or store donates 5% to 10% of what you spend to prevent family homelessness. PENTECOST SUNDAY!

Today is Pentecost Sunday, one of the great solemnities of the Church. Only Easter ranks higher! *Pentēkostē* is the Greek name for the Feast of Weeks, a prominent feast in the calendar of ancient Israel celebrating the giving of the Law on Mount Sinai. This feast is still celebrated as Shavuot in Judaism. For Christians it became the feast commemorating the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and other disciples of Jesus Christ as described in the Acts of the Apostles (Acts 2:1-31). While those on whom the Spirit had descended were speaking in many languages, the Apostle Peter stood up with the Eleven and proclaimed to the crowd that this event was the fulfillment of God's word: "I will pour out my spirit." Three thousand people gladly received his word and were baptized Catholics that day. No wonder we call it the "birthday" of the Church!

Come Holy Spirit, fill the hearts of your faithful and kindle in them the fire of your love.

> Send forth your Spirit and they shall be created. And You shall renew the face of the earth.

O, God, who by the light of the Holy Spirit, did instruct the hearts of the faithful, grant that by the same Holy Spirit we may be truly wise and ever enjoy His consolations.




