

BAPTISMAL PREPARATION PROGRAM

The Sacrament of 'The Anointing of the Sick' At All Masses October 12-13

On the weekend of October 12 & 13, at all our Masses, we will offer the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick to any person who wishes to receive it. It has been our custom to offer the sacrament in this manner twice a year. We hope that anyone afflicted by a serious physical or emotional illness, those recovering from or preparing for surgery, or those who experience age-related limitations will receive the sacrament. In the sacrament we always receive the grace of God's healing. The two essential parts of the sacrament are the 'laying on' of hands and the anointing with the Oil of the Sick. The celebration of this Sacrament, with the whole community present and praying for one another, is always a powerful and beautiful experience.

Novena to St. Joseph Continues Tomorrow Night With Kris Correira

Our 13th Annual Novena to St. Joseph continues tomorrow, Monday, September 30, at 7:15 pm. Each evening lasts just 45 minutes and concludes with Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament. Kris Correira, our parishioner, will make tomorrow's presentation. The Novena includes prayer for the seriously ill, for improvements in palliative care, and to raise awareness about all attempts to end human life unnaturally as in the case of physician assisted suicide or euthanasia. Here's how they work: You purchase food or gift cards in various amounts of \$10 to \$100; You use the food cards for your shopping; You receive the full-face value of the card you purchase; What you don't spend remains on your card for later use; The supermarket or store donates 5% to 10% of what you spend to prevent family homelessness. Consider Joining A Choir Here

Our two church choirs - the **Folk Group** and the **Festival Choir** - are always looking for new voices. Would you consider joining one of them?

The **Festival Choir** sings at the 11:00 am Mass each Sunday morning in the academic year (they take the summer off). They also sing on special holy days like Christmas and some of the services of Holy Week and Easter). The Festival Choir **rehearses most Thursday nights** from 7:00 to 8:30 pm. They just had their first rehearsal of the year this past Thursday night but it is certainly not too late (in never is) to join.

The Folk Group sings on the second and fourth Sundays of the month at the 9:00 am Mass. If there is a fifth Sunday in a month they generally sing at that too. They rehearse on Wednesday evenings from 7:30 to 9:00 pm but only on the Wednesday that precedes a Sunday they will sing. So, on average, two rehearsals a month.
