

# This Wednesday, January 22 Day of Prayer for the Legal Protection of Unborn Children

The Catholic Church throughout the United States will observe this day. It reminds us of our preeminent priority to pray and work for an end to the tragic scourge of abortion. We pray for the right to life. And it is a day of penance for the violations to the dignity of the human person committed through acts of abortion.

Legalized abortion is now an issue for individual states to resolve. Our work is far from over. Let us together unite our hearts and minds through special acts of prayer, fasting, and sacrifice that day.

Bishop McManus has written, "As we reflect on this unspeakable tragedy, we also recall how the Church for many years has continued to reach out to those who have been so sadly affected by the culture of death, particularly through ministries providing aid to women and families in crisis pregnancies, offering the healing love and mercy of Christ to those wounded by abortion through the ministry of Project Rachel, and by continuing to teach and preach the truth and beauty about love and life that bring authentic freedom and happiness. It is through our prayers, charitable works, and loving sacrifices that the culture can be transformed."

Here's how they work: You purchase food or gift cards in various amounts of \$10 to \$100; You use the food cards for your shopping; You receive the full-face value of the card you purchase; What you don't spend remains on your card for later use; The supermarket or store donates 5% to 10% of what you spend to prevent family homelessness. #### The Decree of Bishop McManus on the Jubilee Year

A Jubilee, or Holy Year, is a special year of forgiveness, reconciliation, conversion and celebration. In Jewish tradition, the Jubilee Year was a time of joy, the year of remission or universal pardon. "Thou shalt sanctify the fiftieth year, and shalt proclaim remission to all the inhabitants of thy land: for it is the year of jubilee." (Leviticus 25:10). In the Roman Catholic tradition, Jubilees date back to Pope Boniface VIII who convoked a Holy Year in 1300. Since then, ordinary Jubilee years have been celebrated every 25 or 50 years. An important part of a Holy Year is making a pilgrimage to sacred places, particularly the designated Churches in Rome and passing through the Holy Door at the Papal Basilica of Saint Peter. The Jubilee Year 2025 has been called for by our Holy Father, Pope Francis as a Year of Hope. As the Holy Father wrote in the Bull of Indiction for the Holy Year, "Hope, together with faith and charity, makes up the triptych of the "theological virtues" that express the heart of the Christian life. In their inseparable unity, hope is the virtue that, so to speak, gives inward direction and purpose to the life of believers."

In view of this, I, The Most Reverend Robert Joseph McManus, Bishop of the Diocese of Worcester, in union with his Holiness, Pope Francis, encourage the faithful of this Diocese to observe prayerfully and with renewed devotion the Jubilee Year of the Lord 2025. In addition to pilgrimages to Rome, I have designated ten churches in our Diocese as official "Churches of Pilgrimage." Those faithful visiting these churches will receive the spiritual graces and benefits of this Jubilee Year. I hereby designate the following as Churches of Pilgrimage for the Jubilee Year 2025:

The Cathedral of Saint Paul, Worcester; Our Lady of the Holy Rosary Church at Annunciation Parish, Gardner; Our Lady of the Rosary Church at Mary, Queen of the Rosary Parish, Spencer; Notre Dame Church at Saint John Paul II Parish, Southbridge; Saint Cecilia Church, Leominster; Saint Paul Church at Divine Mercy Parish, Blackstone; Saint John the Evangelist Church at Saint John, Guardian of our Lady Parish, Clinton; Sacred Heart of Jesus Church, Milford; Saint Matthew Church. Southborough; and Saint Joseph Basilica, Webster.


