

GUIDELINES FOR FAST AND ABSTINENCE IN LENT

Lenten fast and abstinence regulations for the Diocese of Worcester are as follows: **Abstinence from meat** is to be observed by all Catholics fourteen (14) years of age and older on **Good Friday** and all the **Fridays of Lent**. **Fasting** is to be observed by all Catholics who are eighteen (18) years of age but not yet fifty-nine (59) years of age on **Good Friday**. Those who are bound to fast may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted. Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed Lenten penitential practices.

Tuesday Night Confessions During Lent

We will offer the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Penance; confessions) on Lenten Tuesdays between 7:00 pm and 8:00 pm. Lent is a wonderful time to receive God's mercy through this sacrament of healing. In addition to Saturday afternoons (2:45-3:45 pm), we will offer confessions on Tuesday evening April 8. During Holy Week confessions will be offered several afternoons and evenings.

A Cursillo weekend is a three-day Catholic retreat designed to deepen faith, offer spiritual growth, and foster a sense of community among participants. It emphasizes prayer, community, and evangelization, aiming to help individuals live a more authentic Christian life. The word Cursillo, meaning 'short course' in Spanish, is a movement that brings essential Christian truths to life in a way that is both personal and communal. There are Cursillo weekends for Men and others for Women. The local retreats take place at Immaculate Conception Center in Putnam, CT. Sin is a fact of life. We all fall prey to sin, no matter the time of year. Some sins are called *venial*, because they weaken the life of grace and make it more likely that a person will fall into *mortal* (serious) sin - the kind of sin, which because of its gravity, extinguishes the life of grace. But all sin separates us from God.

Jesus wants to free us from sin and give us the life of grace. The first step along that path is to make a good, sincere, confession of our sins. Even if it has been a long time since a person last went to Confession, there's no reason to be afraid. Discover Christ's mercy in the Sacrament of Reconciliation!
