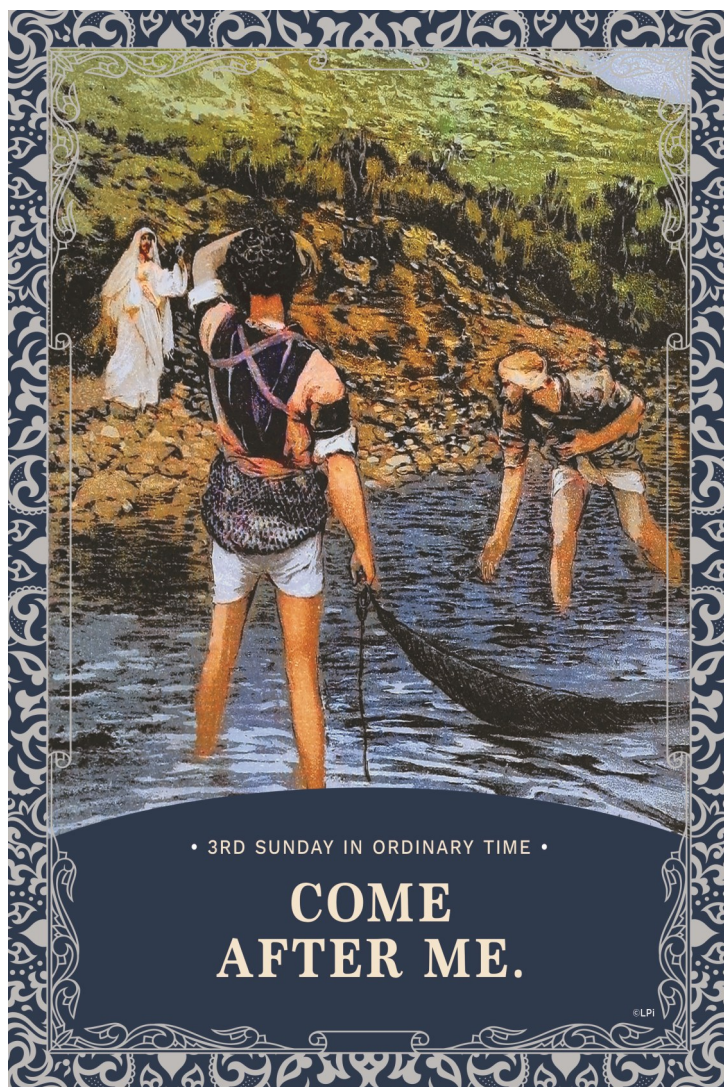

St. John Paul II on Martin Luther King

In 1987, Pope St. John Paul II visited New Orleans. He took the occasion to comment on Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., pointing to his fearless courage in the face of opposition. The pope said, "Today as we recall those who with Christian vision opted for non-violence as the only truly effective approach for ensuring and safeguarding human dignity, we cannot but think of the Reverend Doctor **Martin Luther King, Jr.**, and of the **providential role** he played in contributing to the rightful human betterment of black Americans and therefore to the improvement of American society itself."

St. John Paul II also expressed his desire that the Church would join the efforts of others in the fight for justice: "The Church must continue to join her efforts with the efforts of others who are working to correct all imbalances and disorders of a social nature. Indeed, *the Church can never remain silent in the face of injustice, wherever it is clearly present.*" It should be noted that one of the most important parts of King's legacy was his Christian beliefs that fueled his activism. He saw all people as children of God and firmly believed that they all should be given the same respect and God-given dignity.

Have Your Marriage Blessed?

Monsignor Sullivan is a Notary Public

For many years Monsignor Sullivan has been a notary public. Should any parishioner need to have a document notarized you are welcome to call upon him. There will be no fee for any notarizations. He is simply happy to assist you. Just call the rectory should you need this service.

Who is a Godparent for Baptism &/or a Sponsor for Confirmation?

The issue of the selection of godparents for Baptism or a sponsor for Confirmation is a very important one. Making a choice of a person who is (1) a fully initiated Catholic and (2) who will be an excellent role model in the faith for the young person is important. For Baptism, in Church law, only one godparent is required, though most people prefer two and generally have two (if they can find two persons who meet the requirements below).

A godparent or sponsor must be at least 16 years of age and (1) a baptized Catholic (2) a confirmed Catholic and (3) a practicing Catholic. By a “*practicing Catholic*” we mean that the *person must go to Mass every Sunday*. Their pastor should know them from Sunday Mass. *A sponsor certificate* from that person’s home pastor, signifying all three, *is mandatory*. It must be received in advance of the Baptism or Confirmation. Most often, pastors will *not prepare* a sponsor certificate for a proposed godparent if the 3 conditions above are not met. Parents should ask their proposed godparents to obtain their sponsor certificates well in advance of the date of the baptism (the same for Confirmation sponsors). It must be presented to the pastor of the church where the baptism is to take place well in advance of the baptism.

If a potential godparent is married, he or she must be in a “sacramental marriage.” If unmarried, he or she cannot be “living with a person,” for example. Their moral life should be exemplary in every way. If parents are unable to find two suitable candidates for godparents for a Baptism, they can have one godparent and one “*Christian witness*.” For a baptism, if a non-Catholic is chosen to serve as a “Christian witness” (a practicing Protestant or Orthodox) he or she must be a Christian (not Jewish, Islamic, Buddhist, no religion, etc.) This person is listed in the baptismal register as a “Christian witness,” not a godparent. Confirmation sponsors must be Roman Catholic.
