

**ASH WEDNESDAY**  
**THIS WEDNESDAY ~ FEBRUARY 18**

**Ash Wednesday** is the first day of Lent. We will offer 6 Masses, spread throughout the day, enabling everyone to find the time to come to Mass, receive ashes and begin the holy season of Lent. The Masses will be at **7:00 am, 9:00 am, 12:00 noon, 3:00 pm, 5:30 pm and 7:00 pm**. Music will be offered at the last three Masses. Following the homily, the priest will bless the ashes with a prayer, sprinkle the ashes with holy water in the customary fashion, and impose (with others) ashes on the foreheads of all who come forward.

**Weekday Evening Mass during Lent!**

Throughout Lent, Christ the King offers a **Mass at 5:30 pm Monday through Friday**. This begins on Ash Wednesday and concludes the day before Holy Thursday. It is perfect for those who cannot attend a morning Mass.

### "COME HOME TO GOD'S MERCY" Tuesday Night Confessions During Lent

Several years ago, Bishop McManus requested that every parish in the Diocese offer opportunities for Catholics to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation (Penance; confessions) on Lenten Tuesdays **between 7:00 pm and 8:00 pm**. We continue this practice. Lent is a wonderful time to receive God's mercy in this extraordinary Sacrament. In addition to Saturday afternoons (2:45-3:45 pm), we will be offering confessions on Lenten Tuesday evenings. They begin February 24 (the first full week of Lent) and continue on March 3, March 10, March 17, March 24 and March 31 (which falls during Holy Week). During Holy Week there will be additional confessions from 3:00 to 4:00 pm and 7:00 to 8:00 pm on each of the following days: Monday, March 30, Tuesday, March 31, and Wednesday, April 1...as well as on Holy Saturday, April 4 from 2:45 to 3:45 pm.

### HOSPITAL VISITS UPDATE

The priest chaplains at our hospitals continue to serve the pastoral needs of their patients. Please let us know if someone you know is hospitalized and Msgr. Sullivan will be happy to visit that person. The best thing is for a family member or friend to call the rectory to let us know your loved one is in the hospital. For years we have **not been able to obtain any information** from **St. Vincent's Hospital, UMass Hospital** (at the Lake) or **Memorial Hospital** about patients listed by their parishes. Therefore, you must call the rectory if you would like Msgr. Sullivan to visit a loved one. Sadly, Monsignor is entirely dependent on information that you can provide!

### GUIDELINES FOR FAST AND ABSTINENCE

Lenten fast and abstinence regulations for the Diocese of Worcester are as follows:

**Abstinence from meat** is to be observed by all Catholics fourteen (14) years of age and older on **Ash Wednesday, Good Friday** and **all the Fridays of Lent**.

**Fasting** is to be observed by all Catholics who are eighteen (18) years of age but not yet fifty-nine (59) years of age on **Ash Wednesday** and **Good Friday**. Those who are bound to fast may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted. Catholics should not lightly excuse themselves from these prescribed Lenten penitential practices.

### Stations of the Cross Lenten Friday Afternoons

We celebrate the Stations of the Cross each Friday during Lent. We resumed this practice 4 years ago, and a good number of people come. The time is **3:00-3:30 pm**. We encourage you to join in.

# Lent

In Lent, which begins this Wednesday, we are exposed to the entire mystery of what God has done for us in Christ. The austerity of the season - marked by simplicity, sacrifice and renewed prayerfulness - is dictated not only by sorrow for sin but also as a time of waiting and anticipation for the coming Easter celebration. Joy is as much a keynote of the season as austerity. It is the joy of those who know that while they are sinners, God's merciful love has been revealed through Jesus Christ.

The whole of the Lenten season looks forward with anticipation to the *Triduum* (Holy Thursday, Good Friday and the great Vigil on the eve of Easter), which fully reveals what we will be seeking during the forty days ahead: to die and rise to new life with Christ.

Lent is baptismal, too, because Christian life is baptismal. To be baptized is to die with Christ and rise with him to new life, a process initiated at Baptism, to be sure, but one that is not entirely completed until we rise with him on the last day.

Lent, then, is a time of baptismal renewal, when the Church lingers over the meaning of Baptism - not as a past event in our lives but as a vocation to be lived, not as something that happens merely to individuals but as the task of the whole Church until her Lord comes in glory. It is the time when the Church reaffirms her reason for existence and rededicates herself to her task of *being* the body of Christ.
