

GOOD SHEPHERD SUNDAY

Today is Good Shepherd Sunday and Prayer for Vocations to the Priesthood and Religious Life. Currently our diocese has two seminarians in Rome, two applicants on the pre-seminary course in Salamanca, and one on the inquirer's programme; one who will be ordained to the permanent diaconate in the autumn; and we know of some women presently discerning vocations to religious life. In his Vocations Letter Pope Francis has encouraged us to foster a culture of vocational discernment in our young so they hear what God wants of them. We keep this intention for all our young people in our prayers. The Novena for Vocations to the Priesthood, Diaconate and Consecrated Life begins today - a poster and some leaflets are available in the porch.
