Friends of Divine Mercy Scotland are back on the road with the MERCY BUS to spread the Joy of the Gospel

After the wonderful response to the Mercy Bus last year when over 200 people boarded the Mercy Bus and over 1,000 Miraculous Medals and Divine Mercy Chaplets were given to the people we spoke to on the streets of Scotland, we are back out on the road this summer. Pope Francis asks us to take the church out to the people as they no longer are coming to the church. The Friends of Divine Mercy Scotland is doing just that! A seed planted during the Paisley Diocesan Synod in 2016.
