Mass Intentions

When a priest celebrates Mass each day, he *offers* each celebration of the Eucharist for a particular person, or intention. By doing so he applies special graces from God upon that person or intention. Similar to how we are able to intercede for others by our personal prayers, the Church is able to intercede for us through the celebration of the Mass

Here at St. Peter, the cost of a Mass intention is \$10 but the priest will offer a Mass for an intention even if someone doesn't have the money for it.. The important part is to remember that you are not paying for the *graces* from God, but for the material things that are involved with celebrating that particular Mass.

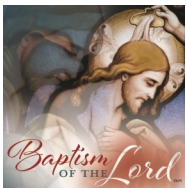

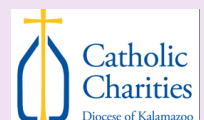

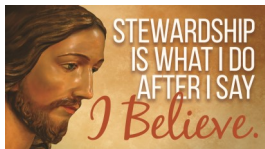
Diocesan Heating Assistance Program

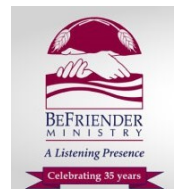

Llenos de ese amor, renovemos nuestro bautismo y vivámoslo con un testimonio alegre, como **Discípulos Misioneros**.
