

You Say Goodbye, and I Say Hello (Or "Mind the Gap")

I first saw the saying "mind the gap" on signs on the light rail system in Toronto. But its origin is with the London Underground (subway, to us Yanks.) I reminds passengers to watch their step as they move from the platform to the train. These gaps on older systems can be significant, wide enough to get a foot caught or drop something you'd rather not drop.

And the other title (I couldn't decide) is from the Beatles' song, similarly titled, "Hello, Goodbye." The Beatles were an influential music group of the 1960's and 70's. To those who remember their blockbuster entry onto the music scene at the time, it might seem not all that long ago. But for scale, the music of the Big Band era was half as old at the time of the Beatles' debut as their music is today. 50 years before "I Wanna Hold Your Hand," the composers Claude Debussy, Richard Strauss, and Jean Sibelius were still performing live.

So, here we are, at the "gap." We have said goodbye to Fr. Fabio who isn't exactly going off to explore Antarctica. He will be in Kalamazoo and will reappear here from time to time as one of our esteemed priest "subs." And this weekend (Thursday, for the daily Mass crowd) we say hello to Fr. Evelio. I'm not sure who was our pastor, officially, last Wednesday, July 5. That really was a gap...

But the gap is not quite over. A new pastor has a long to-do list in terms of becoming oriented and integrated into a new parish community. He's the leader, and comes well-equipped to take on that responsibility, but leading a community of strangers is a far cry from leading a community of at least some familiarity. So there's that gap.

A new pastor, as mentioned a few weeks ago, has just left a familiar community that is also something of a family to him. We had about 8 weeks' notice of Fr. Fabio's new assignment, but Fr. Evelio and his parish have had barely half that. So there is the sense of loss that comes with every major life transition, another gap.

A new pastor is not only taking a new job; he's also moving into a new home: where is the silverware drawer? And not only the home environment is different, but so is the workplace: where is the purificator drawer? Still another gap.

A parish community, even a modest-sized one like ours, is a complex organization. Systems are in place;

relationships are established; most things are working pretty well. But a new leader in any organization changes dynamics in ways both intended and unintended, and sometimes with neither intention nor even awareness. Again, a gap to mind.

But a pastor is not just a typical leader. He has a spiritual role arising out of a vocation which is the work of the Holy Spirit calling him to this particular way of serving the Church. Each pastor will inevitably have his own ways of expressing his pastoral care and leadership in the parish community. A lot of gaps to mind, here.

But by "minding" them, nobody has to trip, stumble, fall, or drop something important under the train. We can do this!

Our staff has met with Fr. Evelio, as have Ralph and I, in order to get an initial sense of what he needs to get off to a good start. His first requests of us are patience, support, and keep going as we are going. (And a Surface Pro. Done!)

He also wants to keep the Pastoral Associate (whew!). But that term has two words; same associate, different pastor. (A small gap, nothing too serious.)

In the next few weeks, Fr. Evelio will meet with the Pastoral Council and with the leaders of the various ministries in our parish. And, starting immediately, he'll meet everybody! (Name tags every Sunday through September should help.)

And so we say "Hello" to you, Fr. Evelio! Welcome to St. Peter's and to the collaborative of St. Basil, San Felipe deJesus, and us. May you enjoy a soft landing here at the Lakeshore, may you be blessed with the serenity of knowing you are loved in advance, and may you find joy in bringing your gifts to this community of faith, already thriving and still eager to grow in new ways yet to be revealed to us all!
