Greetings to my brothers and sisters in Christ,

*The Mass 2025/6, Issue Eighteen*

After the Doxology has been chanted by the Priest and all respond “Amen,” the Eucharistic Rite of the Mass is ended and the Priest transitions into the Communion Rite. After the Amen, all stand from their kneeling posture. As I mentioned in a previous issue, standing is a posture of respect, readiness, and, most importantly, worship, symbolizing active, attentive participation in the liturgy. Once all are standing (if they are physically able), the Priest continues, with hands folded, saying, “At the Savior’s command and formed by divine teaching, we dare to say...” (Roman Missal, 124). This invites all to recite the Lord’s Prayer. The Priest begins with “Our Father,” and then all join in this communal prayer originally taught to us by Our Lord Jesus Himself. During the praying of the Our Father, the Priest’s hands are in the Orans position, symbolizing his role as a mediator, praying to God on behalf of the congregation. Traditionally, all others pray with folded hands.

During Mass, the Our Father does not end with “Amen,” but is a call and respond. After praying the Our Father, the Priest continues asking the Lord to deliver us from every evil, to give us peace, to free us from sin by His grace, and to keep us safe from all distress (IBID, 125). Then the people proclaim, “For the kingdom, the power and the glory are yours now and for ever” (IBID).

The priest then extends his hands in the Orans position once again and asks the Lord for His peace, the same peace that He gave the Apostles in the upper room. The Priest also asks the Lord to not look upon our sins, but the faith of His Church, and to grant her (the Church) peace and unity (IBID, 126). The Priest then turns to the people and offers them this peace, asking that it will remain with them always (IBID, 127). All respond to the Priest, “And with your spirit” (IBID). Optionally, the Deacon, or in the absence of the Deacon the Priest himself, can instruct the people to offer each other “the sign of peace” (IBID, 128). There is a misunderstanding about this gesture. Many people take this moment as a break from the Mass and begin waving and chatting with everyone they can see. It is important to remember that we are offering each other the same peace of Christ that the Deacon or Priest just offered to us. The same peace that Jesus gave to His apostles, The same peace that comes directly from God. We sometime see people giving the two-finger peace sign from the 1960 sexual revolution. This is a very different and very human sign of peace and comes from the same place that we get the sex, drugs, and rock & roll tagline. This is not the sign of peace that we should be giving one another. It is actually called the kiss of peace, and it is a double embrace, one to the left and one to the right. The USCCB has agreed that “Catholics exchange a gesture (e.g., handshake, nod, bow) to express unity, peace, and charity. According to Vatican guidelines (2014) supported by the USCCB, it should not be accompanied by a “song of peace,” nor should it cause excessive commotion” (USCCB). The sign of peace is accompanied by saying, “peace be with you,” and the response is the same, “peace be with you.” This gesture is meant for those in our immediate vicinity and should not cause a disturbance. During COVID we had said no handshaking, but now it is permissible and recommended.

After the sign of peace (kiss of peace) the Choir or Priest begins the Agnus Dei (Lamb of God) where all sing or proclaim that the Lamb of God (Jesus Christ) takes away our sins, and asks for His peace (IBID, 130). During the Agnus Dei, the Priest is fracturing the celebrant’s Consecrated host signifying how Jesus’ body was broken on the altar of the Cross for all of humanity. It also signifies that though we are many members, we are part of the same body, and we receive that same body at communion.

The Priest then takes a small part of the body and places it in the chalice, in the blood, signifying the union of the body and the blood at the resurrection, and the union of the Church. While doing this, the Priest is praying that in the mingling of the body and blood we who receive it will be brought into eternal life (IBID, 129). Immediately after this, the Priest bows profoundly before the altar, body, and blood, praying again in a quiet voice that Jesus free him from all his sins, from every evil, and to never let him be parted from God (IBID, 131). This is again the Priest begging God to make him worthy to perform such a sacred task, because it is only through the grace of God that such a sinful person could minister to the divine in this way.

Then the Priest standing upright, elevates the body and blood before the people proclaiming, “Behold the Lamb of God, behold him who takes away the sins of the world. Blessed are those called to the supper of the Lamb” (IBID, 132). And all respond, “Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed” (IBID). Immediately the Priest receives after praying in a low voice that the body and blood of Christ may keep him safe for eternal life (IBID). Immediately after, the Priest will communicate the Deacon if present. Next time we will discuss the community receiving communion and then move on to the Concluding Rite.

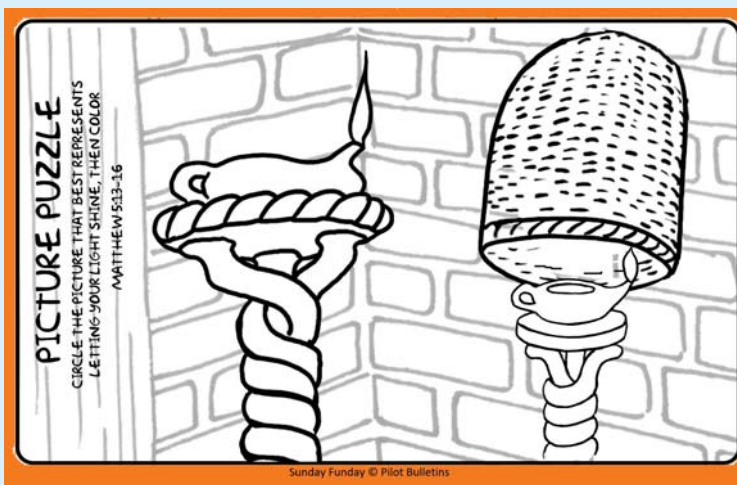

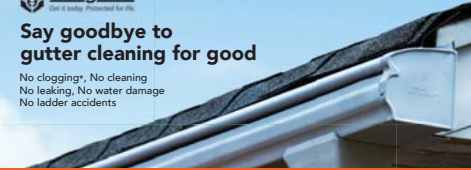
