Faith Formation

Please drop off items for Boxes of Joy by Sunday, November 7th

Details: Our parish is participating in the Boxes of Joy ministry again this year. A nationwide gift outreach by Catholic schools, parishes, and groups facilitated by Cross Catholic Outreach. Through filling the physical boxes (about the size of a shoebox) with toys and other gifts, participants reduce the suffering of children due to poverty by sharing the joy of Christmas. The Knights of Columbus will assist this tangible and straightforward service experience.

Our tradition has been for each Faith Formation class (8:00 am and 10:00 am) to fill at least one Box of Joy using the recommended list of items as a guide

(https://icchurchmd.org/boxes-of-joy-gift-list). The parish has been blessed with the ability to go above this number in past years, donating more boxes than the number of Faith Formation classes. The only request is that each student prayerfully decides what to donate as guided by their family.

There will also be a location in the church to drop off items for the Boxes of Joy. The organizational deadline is November 7th. This deadline will enable organizing the donated items and delivering the boxes to Cross Catholic Outreach for distribution to children near Christmas Day.

The Boxes of Joy program is also an opportunity for the students in our Faith Formation classes to create Christmas cards to include in the boxes. Parents/guardians/responsible adults are encouraged to review the completed Christmas cards to avoid sharing private/personal information. In so doing, providing an effective real-world follow-up to the recent safety training for children.

Health Statement:

We are blessed that there has not been a COVID-19 issue involving a student, classroom catechist, or classroom catechist aide who has attended Faith Formation to date. We ask all who are involved in our Faith Formation program not to attend class if sick, have been exposed to a COVID-19 positive person in the last seven days (and are not vaccinated), live with someone who is COVID-19 positive (and are not vaccinated), is in quarantine due to another exposure, or is awaiting a COVID-19 test result.

If a student, classroom catechist, or classroom catechist aide who has recently attended our religious education program tests positive for COVID-19, they must inform Tim Steelman at steelman@faithformation.us. Along with the local health authorities, we will work with you to develop the necessary communication plan for our community and supportive prayer.
