



Weekly Update on the Archbishop's Catholic Appeal

Signing-up to Attend Mass

Our parish now uses an online system for signing-up to attend Mass. Every Tuesday morning at 9 am, the links are activated on the homepage of our parish website at www.olspdx.org, and you can choose either daily or Sunday Masses. Right now, there is no limit to how many daily Masses you can attend each week, but you can only sign up for one Mass on the weekend.

If you do not care to sign-up online, you can also call the Parish Office during business hours, and we will do the online sign-up for you.

Please note that you should not be signing-up to attend Mass in more than one parish. By doing so, you may be depriving someone else of the chance to attend Mass. Also, please call the office and let us know if you need to cancel your reservation so we can then offer the empty seat to someone else.



No Anointing of the Sick

Currently, we are not offering the Anointing of the Sick at the 12 pm Mass on the First Friday of the month. The sick and ill are highly susceptible to the Coronavirus, and the danger of accidental exposure is too great. The Anointing of the Sick will once again be offered when it is safe to do so.

Planning Underway

Right now, our staff and volunteer catechists are working hard to plan for our Religious Education program this coming year (2020—2021). Our RE program will include Sunday morning classes for the children and youth, faith formation for adults (including RCIA), and preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation for teens. Registration will open in September, but in the meantime, if you have any suggestions, ideas, or questions about our parish’s RE program, feel free to talk to Fr. Chrispine or James.


Please note that we are doing our best to take into consideration what may be happening in the fall with the coronavirus pandemic when planning Religious Education opportunities.




Vacation Bible School

Help Us Keep an Eye Out

Also, if you see him on the grounds after hours, please call the police. He was responsible for a security breach in our school building, so we would greatly appreciate everyone’s help in watching out for him, and maintaining the safety and security of our grounds and buildings.

Burglar Alarms

We are once again turning on the burglar alarms in the school building, which affects the gymnasium, cafeteria (Religious Education Center), and Fr. Carberry Hall. If you do not know how to turn the alarms on or off, do not enter one of these facilities without first letting us know ahead of time in the Parish Office. This is especially important to remember if you are part of a parish group that regularly uses one of these facilities for meetings, sports practices, etc. False alarms, especially ones that the police respond to, can be very expensive and costly for our parish.
