Guíe a su hijo en la preparación para esto mediante:

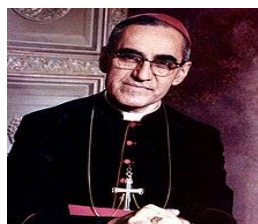
Examen de conciencia: los Diez Mandamientos pueden ser una herramienta útil en este proceso.

Todos están invitados para el Circulo de Oración los Martes después de la Misa a las 6:30PM en el Centro.

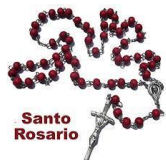


El Triduo de San Oscar Romero, comenzará en la parroquiales de St. Francis para todos los feligreses.
