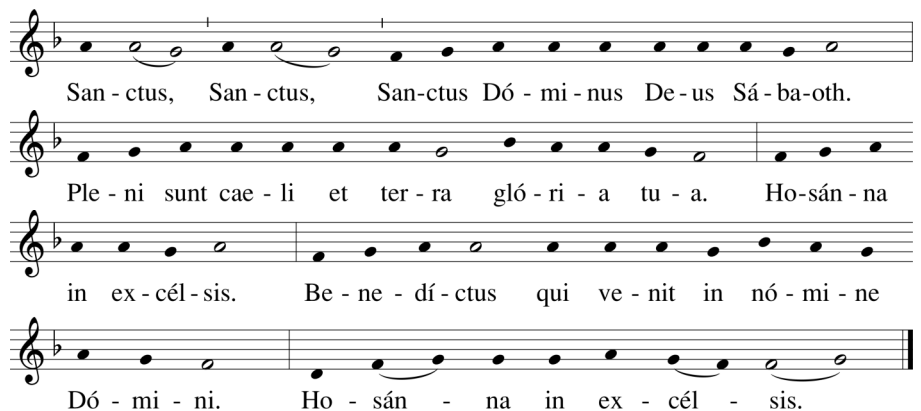

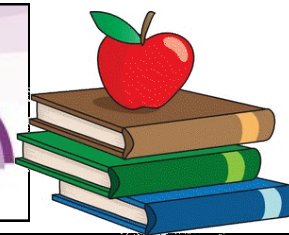
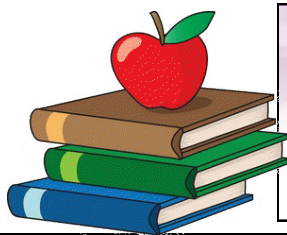

3. Stand up, raise your hand, speak up to get attention.
4. Notify the celebrant or ministers at the altar.
5. Tell someone to call 911.
6. Tell someone to go outside to direct emergency personnel when they arrive.
7. Clear area to attend to the involved parishioner(s).
8. Always know the closest exit.
