Next Sunday we celebrate Jesus’ Ascension into Heaven where He goes to prepare a place for us. Such marvelous promises for those who love the Lord! He speaks those promises not only to His first disciples and apostles, but also to us the beloved of God who are indeed “special” or “blessed” because “even though we have not seen, yet we believe”.

We look around the world in which we live and what do we observe? Tragedies, wars and rumors of war; inflation and many people who are homeless because of strife, hatred and destruction, rising seas, floods and other catastrophes, a lack of unity in our own nation, a loss of sense of the common good, differences even in our own Church, bickering and arguing everywhere, poverty, immigration struggles, drugs and diseases-so much that is upsetting and negative and here is Jesus Christ offering us HOPE and salvation.

We are reminded that God is far more powerful than all the evils of the world combined-that He is a loving God, caring for us as the Good Shepherd and concerned for each of us as His children, who claims us as His own.

Turn to Him with confidence and recognize how we are united with Jesus and the Father: “I am in my Father and you are in me and I in you!”

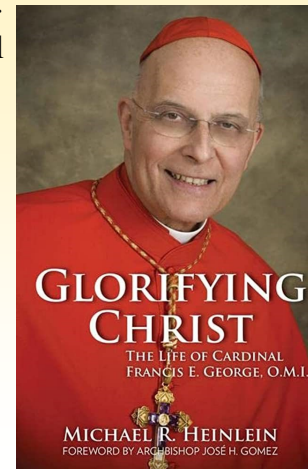
