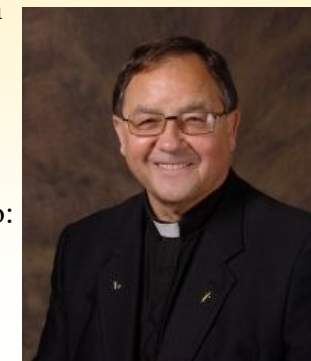
MEMORIAL DAY MASS
