Over and over again in the short passage of the Gospel according to Matthew, proclaimed on this Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time, Jesus reminds us how valuable and important each one of us is to Him and to His Father and at the same time challenges us to be faithful to Him and His teaching and not to fear.

And yet we do fear. We fear disease and sickness, we fear for our children and for their safety, we fear the loss of our way of life and the things we possess, we fear inflation, poverty, loss of importance and respect, the loss of friendships and relationships with others, we fear failing in school or in the sight of our peers, we fear violence, drive-by shootings, dislike by others, the heat, the cold and the list goes on and on.

Don't we also fear of not taking the teaching and words of Jesus seriously and to heart? He tells us over and over: "Do not fear, do not be afraid, "I am always with you." Are we convinced of His promises to us that He will never abandon us? As we have reminded ourselves so often-"If I don't feel close to God, God hasn't moved!" Trust in God, in His promises, in His assurances, must be ours as Catholic Christians. Listen to the words of Jesus and try to abide by them: Fear no one; do not be afraid!
