

“COMMUNION UNDER BOTH SPECIES.”

Beginning on the Holy Day, this Tuesday, The Feast of the Assumption of Mary, we will once again offer the Eucharist under the forms of bread and wine. This privilege is presented to our parishioners and guests as an option. When we receive Holy Communion we receive the total Eucharist even under one species of bread or wine. This renewed practice interrupted by COVID, provides the opportunity for those who wish to avail themselves of it to receive the Precious Blood from the Communion Cup.

There is no pressure to do this and if you have a cold, flu or any communicable disease we ask you not to partake form the Cup. For the present there will be two ministers of the Cup at each weekend Mass (one on weekday Chapel Masses). THERE WILL BE NO INTINCTION OF THE EUCHARIST.

As a review, the Ministers of the Cup will say to each communicant after they receive the Host “The Blood of Christ” and our response is “Amen”. We rejoice that we can again restore this practice beginning with Masses on the Feast of Mary’s Assumption (also Monday evening Vigil Mass).

Please do not feel any obligation to receive under both species. This privilege is offered at your own choice and preference. We are a “Eucharistic People” and the Eucharist is the source and summit of our identity as Catholic Christians. Always receive with awe and reverence for Jesus’ greatest gift to us; **HIS OWN BODY AND BLOOD!**

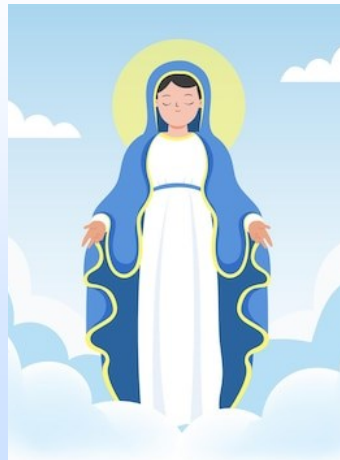
