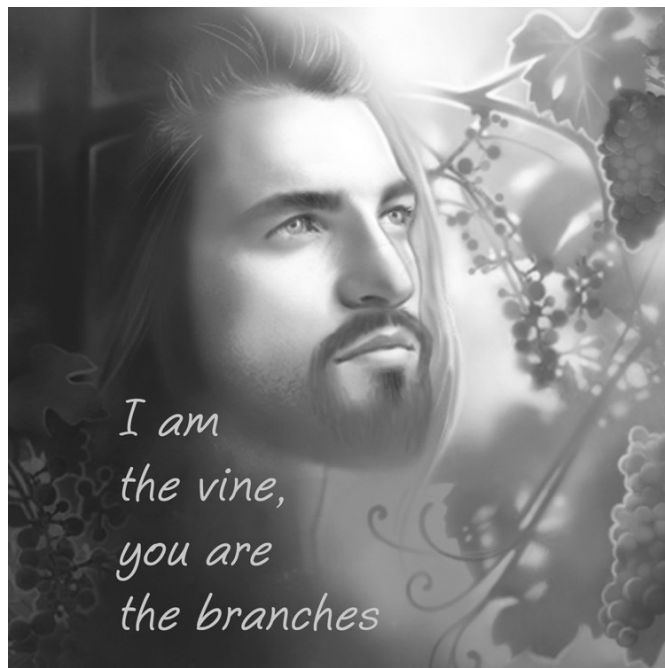

**SPIRITUAL REFLECTION / APR. 29, 2018**

Pruning is hard work. It takes deliberate and focused effort. Sometimes, you have to take what seems to be good branches and cut them so they will either grow in a specific direction or will bear future fruit.

A good pruning can enable us to do what Paul suggests: Love not in word or speech but in deed and truth.

Paul knew of what he was preaching. In his encounter with God on the road to Damascus, he had been pruned and transformed into a different person — once a persecutor of Christians, now a follower and bold witness to Christ.

Can we trust that God only prunes so that we will become a more true witness?

Jesus said to his disciples: "As the Father has loved me, so I have loved you; abide in my love. If you keep my commandments, you will abide in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and abide in his love."
