Your support has been critical to our mission to hear the cries of the poor; to seek and find the forgotten, the suffering or the deprived; and to possess hearts that bring God's love to the poor. In 2018, we made 236 home visits, serving 96 families that included 128 adults and 95 children in our area. In the month of December we made 4 home visits, helping 10 adults and 1 child, and our parish was very generous this Christmas Season in support of our Giving Tree. Through your help, we gave out 30 Christmas family dinner boxes, and eighty-three (83) children each received \$20 in gift cards. We also received support from Goodfellows and Jose's Restaurant for an additional 13 dinner boxes, which we distributed. The impact of your aid this Christmas and throughout the year is immeasurable.
