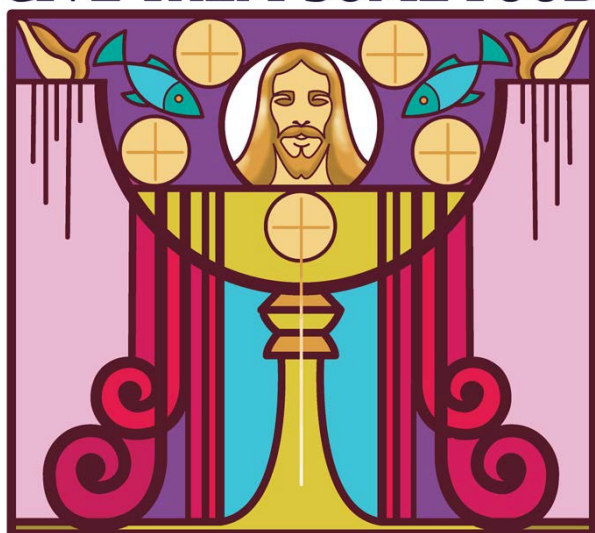

CAR POOL TO PROJECT ONROUTE

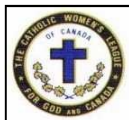

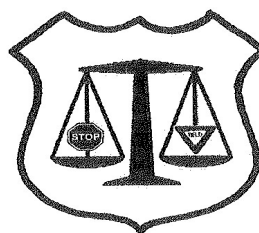

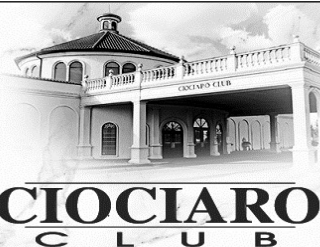
