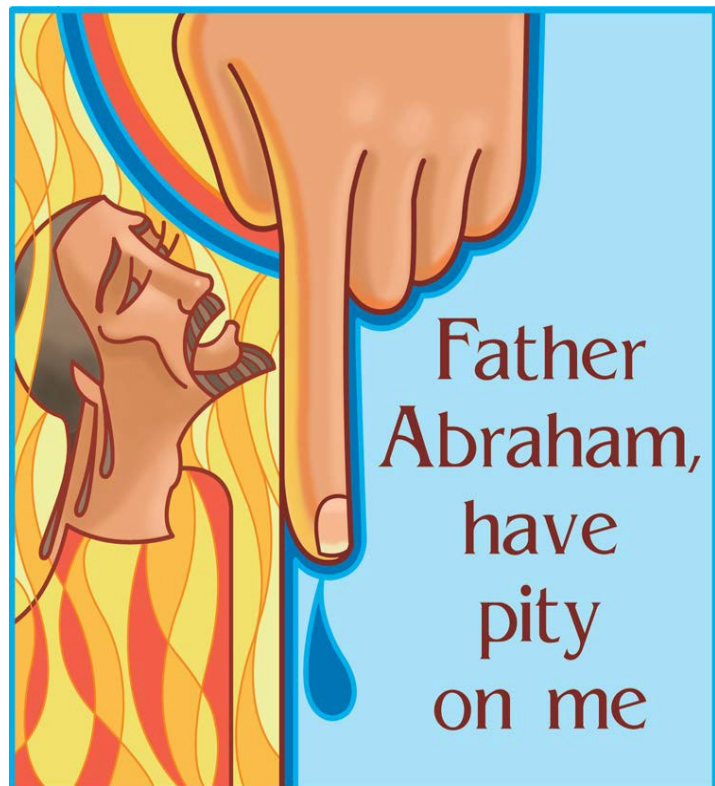

REGISTRATION FOR:

FIRST CONFESSION/FIRST COMMUNION **& CONFIRMATION**

On Sat., Oct. 5 & Sun., Oct. 6, OR Sat., Oct. 12 & Sun. Oct. 13, right after all the Masses, we have scheduled a Sacramental Registration for all parents/guardians of children eligible to receive the sacraments of First Confession/Reconciliation (for children in Grade Two and up), First Communion (for children in Grade Two and up), or Confirmation. (for youth in Grade Eight and up) It is important that you register your child on this day. The sacramental registrations will take place in the church hall. Each child **MUST BE** registered at this time, which will take no longer than 10 minutes.** Please note that your child **MUST** receive the sacrament of First Confession before the reception of First Holy Communion. If your child was not baptized here at Our Lady of Perpetual Help Church or at St. Christopher's Church, Windsor Ontario, please provide a Baptismal Certificate. (or a copy) If your child is not baptized yet and you wish for them to be baptized please speak to Christine at the registration for more information. Due to the cost of educational materials, we request a registration fee of \$45.00 for First Confession & First Communion; and \$45.00 for Confirmation. Be assured that the fee should not stand in the way of your child receiving a sacrament. Please feel free to talk to Fr. Tony or Christine if this is a concern for you or if you need assistance. This fee is only a partial contribution to the total cost of the programs, so we appreciate your support.

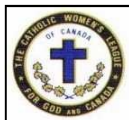

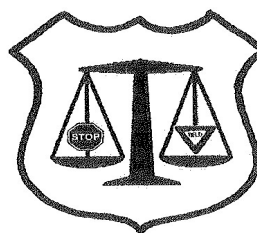
