## Twenty-seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time, October 5, 2025

Today's Gospel reminds us of the power of faith and gratitude. Ten lepers asked Jesus for healing. He does not touch them, but tells them to go and show themselves to the priests ... as if they were already healed. On the way, they are cleansed, but only one returns to give thanks - and it is a Samaritan,

a foreigner despised by the Jews. Jesus shows us that faith and gratitude open our hearts to the fullness of God's gift. We often ask God for help, but we often forget to return and thank Him. Yet true healing begins with a grateful heart. (Fr. W.M.)
