Second, the one who does not carry his cross - that is, the one who avoids the difficulties and responsibilities of daily Christian life (for example, prayer, witnessing to Jesus, living according to His teachings, or raising children in the Christian faith). Third, the one who does not renounce

In today's Gospel, Jesus gives three radical conditions all that he possesses - that is, the one who has no healthy detachment from material goods and is unable to live in true freedom. In other words, Jesus expects from those who wish to become His disciples that He will have the first place in their lives - before all people and before all values, even spiritual ones. And He is absolutely right, because this is truly for our good. Only a right relationship with God allows us to have a right relationship with our neighbor and with all goods - both spiritual and material. (Fr. W.M.)

#### **Special Parish Mission**
