

Thank you to our Bereavement team for helping us with our Annual Commemoration of all of our deceased loved ones last Saturday. Nice job and thank you!

We have been publicizing updates on our Building Our Future capital campaign. We are moving forward in our efforts in a successful campaign so that we can build for our future. It's exciting and it will be revolutionary for our service of our people at Holy Family. As you may recall, our campaign is a COMBINED campaign. Just as we were ready to raise money to build our parish center, the archdiocese began a mandatory "Called To Renew" campaign to build a nest egg for the future of the archdiocese and help parishes in their future capital needs. You may be wondering how our schools are faring despite the challenges of distance learning. I am proud to say that both schools are exceeding my expectations. Obviously, it is not the same as the real thing, actually being physically present in the classroom, but we are attracting a lot of interest due to our success. ### **DID YOU NOW?**

#### Safely store and administer medications for Children

During cold and flu season, many parents give their children a fever reducer, cough syrup, and other medications. These medications can help ease your children's symptoms, but if they're administered or stored improperly, they could put your children at risk. Children are far more susceptible than adults to the effects of medication, because their bodies are smaller and still developing. Even small amounts of drugs can be difficult for them to metabolize, so it's critical to follow your doctor's instructions and to closely monitor children who are old enough to administer their own medication. Ministries will also be able to host events, guest speakers, and even house retreats all in an effort to bring the community close to God.

Our parish center will act as a bridge between the people of our community and the ability to serve our neighboring brothers and sisters. Through the addition of an extensive food pantry, those in need will eventually be able to visit the center and leave with bags full of groceries at no cost to them. Our food pantry will be able to house more items and the set up of the center will allow for direct access into the pantry. With the ever growing number of people going hungry, our parish center will be able to provide relief.

### **ENRICH**

Our journey in faith is a continual process. Along this journey we are meant to transform our lives in the pursuit of becoming people rooted in the truth of Christ. In order to allow ourselves to open up to God's revelation for our lives, we are called to actively pursue an ongoing teaching of the word of God. Our parish center will foster an environment of education, experience, and guidance. The center will have the capacity to hold ministry meetings for as many as 160 people at a time, while also allowing for small groups to intimately meet as well. Updated video and presentation capability will assist with the most efficient means of transmitting beneficial information. Additionally, our parish staff will all be working in the same building. This will lead to increased synergy among the employees, allowing them to work more efficiently to better serve the needs of our ever growing parish. The time spent gathering, discussing, and sharing will pave the way for the people of our community. Our parish center aims to focus on enhancing faith life while deepening our relationship with Christ and those in communion with us.




