Code of Behavior

The ultimate responsibility for maintaining discipline rests with the parent in teaching a child to respect the teacher, others, and church property. All parents and students must sign a Contract of Responsibilities in order to begin or continue in the Confirmation program. **However, a zero tolerance policy is mandated by the** <u>Diocese of Paterson</u> for the following:

- 1. Extremely disrespectful or violent and abusive behavior of any kind toward others; this includes hitting and pushing.
- 2. Bullying, harassment and use of foul language; these are prohibited actions either in-person or electronically.
- 3. Possession of, or abuse of any kind on church property, substances including but not limited to drugs, legal and illegal, inhalants, alcohol and tobacco.
- 4. Possession of any object which may be construed as a weapon of any kind or use of said object on church property. This includes, but is not limited to guns, knives, hammers, and other hardware tools.

For any of these violations, parents will be called immediately to remove the student from the classroom or any Confirmation activity and the appropriate authorities will be notified.
