"That's Tempting!"

"For where your treasure is, there also will your heart be."—Lk. 12:34 Are you fired up? That's tempting, but... What are we to do in the face of temptation? Do we say, "That's tempting, but... no thank you!" Or, do we say, "That's tempting... I know I shouldn't but, oh well," and give in to it anyway?

First of all, what is temptation? St. Thomas Aquinas gives us this definition: "Temptation is nothing more than to be put to the test. When a person is tempted, it is his virtue that is tried." How are we doing in the area of virtue and in the area of resisting temptation? This is part of the spiritual journey. We will struggle with temptation throughout our life as this is the devil's way of trying to take us away from God. It is a struggle that, by ourselves, we will fail in, but with the grace of God and our cooperation with that grace, we can overcome these attacks!

Temptation in and of itself is not evil. It provides, in fact, an opportunity for us to show the Lord that we love Him more than anything else. "Temptation can serve as a means for our growth in virtue and sanctifying grace." (In Conversation with God, Francis Fernandez) So, is the question that we should ask ourselves, "Do we love God? And, if so, "How much do we love Him?"

Oftentimes we fail in our efforts to show people we love them. Take for example a husband or wife who truly love each other but fail to show that love by their actions or inactions. What about the son or daughter who love their parents more than anything in the world but continually hurt them by their bad choices or hurtful words. At some point, in the preceding two examples, there has to be a **proactive effort** that says, "I do love you, and I will put away my selfishness (or whatever it is that keeps you from loving more completely) and show that you mean more than anything in the world to me.

This is the same thing that we have to do in our relationship with God. We have to focus on **His will** and what it is we need to do to show Him the depth of our love. Remember, by ourselves we will fail, but by the grace of God we will overcome!
