

"Serve Together Kokomo"

Several years back, a group of local Christian communities joined forces to spend a weekend performing works of service for citizens, neighborhoods, and community organizations. The initiative was dubbed "Serve Together Kokomo," and the annual event continues to grow.

This year's Serve Together Kokomo falls on Saturday, June 8 and Sunday, June 9 — next weekend — and both St. Patrick and St. Joan of Arc parishes are taking part in working with other local Christians on the many projects around town.

There are four time frames with opportunities to serve. The first is from 10:00 am to 1:00 pm on both Saturday and Sunday; the second is from 1:00 pm to 4:00 pm on each day. We invite you to sign up for one of the time slots if you are able.

Not sure what you can do? Go to the web site **www.servetogetherkokomo.com** and click the "sign up" button. There, you can choose from a variety of projects during any of the four time slots mentioned above.

Regardless of your skill level or interests, there should be *some* opportunity that allows you the chance to share your gifts with others.

For example, if you can swing a hammer you can help build a wheelchair ramp. If you like to paint, there are opportunities to give some local agencies a fresh coat of paint. Have little ones? Sign up to bring a smile to local pedestrians by coloring walkways with "sidewalk chalk." Do you love to make people feel welcome? Sign up to assist with one of the neighborhood cook-outs around town. (Food will be provided!) Do you prefer to serve God and others in prayer? No worries! Click the option to pray around local school campuses — including our very own St. Patrick campus — as volunteers offer prayers for the students, faculty, and staff of our community.

We will also be hosting another **paper shredding event** from 10:00 am to noon on Saturday, June 8. The \$5 donation per box/bag will go to support the Serve Together Kokomo projects.

What a great opportunity to celebrate 160 years of our parish history! Working side-by-side with other Christians throughout our community, we can use our gifts of time and talents to thank God for all He has given us.

To wrap up the weekend, all are invited to worship together at Kokomo Municipal Stadium on Sunday, June 9 at 6:00 pm. You do not have to serve to attend the free worship service!

Our new menu of items needed for the pantry has changed: Fresh oranges, apples, and grapes, canned fruit, canned meat, Tuna Helper (also chicken and beef), spaghetti sauce, drinks like fruit, pop, Kool Aid, water, snacks, shampoo, lotion (right now we have enough deodorants, soaps and paper products).
