"We Are Family!"

Hopefully you're well aware by now that St. Patrick Parish is celebrating its 160th birthday. Can you imagine how many families — and how many individuals — have been part of our parish family over the years? Honestly, it's pretty amazing when you think about it.

But what is even more amazing is realizing that you and I are an important part of that ongoing history! We are part of the *current* "face" of St. Patrick, realizing that many have gone before us and countless others will continue our parish's story after we are gone. That thought is not meant to be depressing or morose; rather, it is a reason for us to celebrate! We are part of a beautiful family with an equally beautiful story in Kokomo.

When you are a member of a parish with over 700 families, though, it might seem nearly impossible to know all the people who call St. Patrick home. We might recognize a name,... we might recognize a face, ... but oftentimes we are unable to put the name with the face.

Imagine how difficult that can be for Father. He has multiple Masses on the weekend (not counting the daily Masses), and with three entrances to the church, he only gets to see a percentage of the parishioners as they leave the building.

There are many times when Father gets a call that a parishioner is in immediate need of a priest. Perhaps it's a medical emergency or a death in the family. It's not uncommon for Father — Fr. Dudzinski or *any* parish priest — to turn to the parish directory before rushing out the door. It helps him put in his mind a picture of the person or family who has called for his presence and support.

All too often, that parishioner or family is not pictured in the directory. Why not? Perhaps they were too busy when the photographer was here. Maybe they thought nobody cares whether they are included or not. They possibly didn't like the way their hair looked just didn't think it was important.

Know this — **we are family**, and we *want* you to be included in our parish directory. It might come in handy for Father, it helps other parishioners get to know you, and it shows that you are indeed part of the history of St. Patrick Parish!

6 How to Report an Incident of Sexual Abuse of a Minor

If you or someone you know has been a victim of child sexual abuse by a person working for the Roman Catholic Church in the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana (such as a priest, deacon, sister, brother, lay officer, lay employee, lay volunteer, etc.) you are requested to report the incident in the following manner:

- 1) Make a report to Child Protective Services by calling 800-800-5556.
- 2) Call the Office of the Vicar General (800-942-2397) or the Office of Assistance Ministry (800-533-7018) for the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana.
- 3) Compose in writing a detailed description of the facts/incidents of the abuse and send it as soon as possible to: Mr. Max Layden, 712 Chase Building, Lafayette, IN 47901.
- 4) Thereafter, an investigation will be undertaken by or on behalf of the Diocese of Lafayette-in-Indiana.

Cómo denunciar un incidente de abuso sexual contra un menor

Si usted o alguien que conoce ha sido víctima del abuso sexual infantil por parte de una persona que trabaje para la Iglesia Católica-Romana en la Diócesis de Lafayette en Indiana (tal como un sacerdote, diácono, religioso, funcionario laico, empleado, voluntario, etc.) se le pide que denuncie el incidente de la siguiente forma:

- 1) Realice una denuncia ante la organización de protección para menores llamando al 800-800-5556.
- 2) Llame a la Oficina del Vicario General (800-942-2397) o a la oficina del ministerio de asistencia (800-533-7018) de la Diócesis de Lafayette en Indiana.
- 3) Redacte una descripción detallada de los hechos e incidentes de dicho abuso y envíela tan pronto como sea posible a: Mr. Max Layden, 712 Chase Building, Lafayette, IN 47901.
- 4) Posteriormente, la Diócesis de Lafayette en Indiana o un representante de ésta, llevará a cabo una investigación.
